The simple life of these great wise people and their plain, commendable teachings attract the sensible seekers and help the latter to attain the wisdom of Life and God. The people, who come across these wise men and their teachings, cannot remain the same. They get transformation. The transformation enables them to comprehend both Life and God.

The divine wise personalities are the Golden People of the world. If every individual could be aware of these wise people and understands their teachings, oh, that time shall be the Golden Period in human history. There have been Golden People at all the times on this beautiful Earth, but, alas, there has never been such a Golden



Period in this world at any point of time. It remains a utopia. The awareness of wise people still eludes from the grasp of most of the mankind.

The followers of the successors had further diluted the teachings by focusing mainly on the physical needs and comforts of the human life. They enthusiastically, but erroneously exaggerated the life and teachings of wise people and misled the mankind. They had repeatedly done it in organized ways. The common people believed them and followed them. Finally, their endeavours ended in the formation of Religions.

The successors found the simple and plain teachings of wise people difficult to practice. They could only exhibit their apparent piety on

wise people by repeating the wise words of their masters. Being simple and honest was impossible for the successors. They failed to understand the fundamental truth that only by practicing the teachings they could impress and transform the common people and not simply by repeating the words of wise people with their own erroneous interpretations on them. It is evident that from the beginning the so-called devoted successors wanted to preach, but not prepared to live the teachings of wise people.

The successors of wise people and their followers floated many unfounded beliefs in the name of wise people. Later the beliefs were developed further, and cults were formed based on the beliefs. The cults brought in strange images of Gods. Some of the cults built worshipping places for their Gods and created strange rituals to worship them. The heads of the cults authorized some sect of people to perform those rituals. They believed that the rituals would please Gods. They also believed that Gods would free people, who spent money to conduct the rituals, from the pains and problems of the transient life. In due course the cults took the shape of religions.

Gradually the religions and their rituals focused mostly on the comforts of the daily life to attract people.

The wise people advocated for a simple life consisted of love, sacrifice, and service, but the successors and followers of the same wise people lost themselves in the illusionary pleasures and comforts of life. Whereas the wise people's mission was to enable people to understand the insignificant transient life and focus their attention on the Eternal Divinity, the religions with its rituals that are standing in the names of the same wise people concentrate only on the mundane life, its petty pleasures, possessions, pains, and problems and put God beyond the reach of the common people. It's the painful truth. All these have been done in the Name of God.

In this process the mankind loses the value of human life which is meant for love, sacrifice, and service. Selfishness has no place in the teachings of wise people, whereas the self and its security have become all important in the religious life.

The religions and the religionists have fragmented the life. They divide the life into accumulations and renunciations. They design rituals accordingly. In this way, the daily life has been separated from the sphere of God. Love has been lost. Hatred and mistrust have become the way of life and thus the religions have become the cause for conflicts and wars due to their divisive characters. People who are influenced by these religions are naturally violent and greedy. They do anything to protect their idiotic beliefs and remain ignorant of all pervading God.

All the religions were founded on the teachings of wise people after their demise. The religions that were formed to mould the people's social life and guide them to God, in due course have become the institutionalized organizations for beliefs, rituals, possessions, greed and power. God is fragmented by the unwanted beliefs and rituals. The different beliefs and rituals in the names of Gods have brought disharmony and conflicts among the people. The beliefs and rituals of any religious orientation could never bring harmony among the people or guide them to God.

One doesn't have the need to believe Sun's existence, it's enough to see, the wise people explained. One doesn't have the need, similarly, to believe God's existence, it's enough to see God by erasing one's 'self', the wise people declared. Seeing God in everything and in everybody would bring forth love, equality, understanding, harmony, clarity, and wisdom. But the 'self' stands like a huge rock preventing the vision of God. Almost all the religions recommend some beliefs and rituals to overcome the pains and problems of life. They say, by having the blind faith on the religious beliefs and conducting the prescribed rituals, people can have wealthy, healthy, knowledgeable, happy, and love-filled life. The craze for longing to possess the transient health, wealth, knowledge, pleasures, authority, and

relationship strengthens 'self', whereas the teachings of wise people is all about renouncing and submitting everything one has unto the feet of God.

The wise people assure that this act of surrendering would erase the 'self' and consequently the pure love would emerge. The pure love would take one to God. This simple teaching of the great wise people was polluted with professional precision by the religionists and made it impossible for the normal human beings to apply it in their life. Nowadays the religions that are believed to bestow wisdom, bliss, peace, and solace upon the people have become the cause for ignorance, pain, violence, and destruction among the mankind.

The divine wise people, who came later also repeatedly attempted to impart the divine wisdom to the masses. They tried to remove the false religious superstitions and rituals. But they were mercilessly persecuted, sometimes killed by the religious fanatics of those times. Even then a few brave seekers could understand the teachings of wise people and realize the

absurdity of the false concepts of religions and their rituals. Those few people transcended the religions and attained the fulfilment of Life and Truth. Ultimately, they became one with the wise people and God.

The wise people of later periods passed on the teachings of ancient wise people to the public by writing scores of epics and philosophies. The people went through those works, glorified them, memorized them, and propagated them, but, alas, except a few, none tried to receive the message out of them and practice them in their lives. For them the teachings and epics were to be worshiped, memorized, chanted, and propagated. They formed rituals to worship God. They believed that they would attain great good things in the life and would near God too by doing those rituals.

In due course they formed cults based on their beliefs. They started memorizing and worshipping the teachings of wise people in organized ways. They added new rituals later to worship the teachings. They believed that they could attain powers through those rituals. They

believed that they were the God men who had the right to preach people. They didn't realize that they had gathered only the theoretical knowledge of the teachings of wise people, but not had gained the wisdom of wise people.

They were mistaken about identifying the wisdom. Mere usage of knowledge makes one clever and it would strengthen one's ego. Knowledge, love, universal vision, and renunciation of the 'self' should blend and there comes the wisdom which doesn't allow ego to exist. This egoless wisdom radiates peace and bliss.

The clever people, mostly the religious ones, ignorantly attempt to imitate wise people for their own personal glory, pleasures, welfare and comforts. They gave more importance to the transient social life with its needs and desires and couldn't think about a life of love, renunciation, and wisdom, which alone would take them to God. Alas, such ignorant lot doesn't understand the value of wise people and their teachings.

Of course, there are always, here and there a few people, who sincerely and seriously probe and contemplate the Truth of life as per the perception of wise people. They try to reach the wholeness of life. These people, by God's Grace get the proximity of living wise people and are guided by the latter to become one with God. Such people never bother about their physical comforts and social positions. They would have one pointed attention on wise people. They acquire wisdom to certain extent. They try to understand the obstacles on their way to God and remove them with their acquired wisdom. Only a few among them could succeed in it and attain the wholeness of Life, God.

The others try to go in the path of wise people, but they gradually get tired on the way to God. They drop halfway through. Due to the lack of wholehearted interest, faith and energy, they lose their focus and fail to pursue the path towards God. This inefficient lot is caught in the mass web of illusory life and religions. They would perform the religious rituals and social routines. They would struggle throughout their life and die.

The few divine people, who have succeeded in attaining God, become immortal. They live eternally in the memory of the real aspirants of God. They are the Guiding Stars and the only hope for the salvation of the whole humanity.

The common people wish to have safe distance from the wise people. They imagine that by having the close proximity with wise people they would lose their identity and the pleasures of life. They fear that they would also become recluse like the wise people. The thoughts of isolation and beggary lifestyle terrorize them. So, they continue to hide themselves behind the crowded religious beliefs and religious people and keep safe distance from the wise people.

The wise people preached the people to transcend rather empty the 'self' for the direct perception of Truth and God. But the common, religious people want to retain their 'self' to enjoy the pleasures of this transient life. They want God to help them to fulfil their desires and ambitions. They do various religious rituals to please God. They believe that the religious ways of worshipping God would fulfil their desires.

They hope that the religious disciplines would provide them the pleasures of life as well as the wisdom of God. They do not know that chasing after pleasures and seeking for God cannot go together.

The religious people give more importance to the pleasures and possessions of life and give no importance to the probing and searching for God. They always pray for protection and fulfilment of their desires. Such, the religions try to protect the 'self' and its possessions, whereas the wise people teach the mankind to drop the 'self' by renouncing and submitting everything to God.

Nowadays the religions have become the cause for enmity among the people. The religionists want to uphold their religious beliefs and protect them from their competitors. In the name of religions and God, the religious fanatics are fighting and killing their opponents mercilessly. They cruelly plan to eliminate the people of other religions from their soil. The divisions within the same religions also breed violence among them to establish their superiority in the society. This trend is rapidly growing throughout the world.

The fanatical religious people have dumped the basic human morals of love and sacrifice. They recklessly lead the mankind to fight and kill the fellow human beings in the names of Gods and religions.

If one could erase one's identity, 'self' and remember God as suggested by wise people, the world would become war-free. The divine wisdom would germinate in everybody's heart. Love alone would prevail in the whole world. This plain simple truth becomes hard task for the religious people.

They teach that human life is meant to realize God, the Truth, by loving all. They say that life is meant to understand the falsehood and to come out of the ignorance. It should not be misused to uphold the falsehood in violent methods.

One should have the self-observation that would reveal the conditioning of the 'self'. they proclaim that they want to see God! They don't have the courage either to see their own lives, but they imagine that they crave to see God, aspire to know God and desire to become one with God!

This crazy attitude of the religious people is astonishing. They may have the apparent devotion on God as suggested by some religious bigheads and conduct religious rituals, roam around worshipping places, donate money and render the so-called social services, but in their houses, in their personal lives, oh God, it is horrible to see their real faces. On seeing the real faces of such religious people, one may like to warn, "Beware of such religious people." These senseless religious people are neither helpful to their families nor useful to the society.

Perhaps, if one can observe one's own life with all seriousness and probe God with clarity, he may get the opportunity to have the close associations with wise people. The associations with wise people help one to come across the Divine Immensity, Infinite Vastness and the source of all existences, GOD. These great souls are the real

devotees, and they alone should be called as 'wise people'.

Such wise people, full of love and compassion are the benediction to the whole humanity. The so-called God Men of all religions around the world are doing serious self-propaganda. Lot of advertisements about such God Men and their products are available in all the modern advertising systems. Scores of methods and systems to attain stress free divine state are available at affordable price from these God Men. The so-called God Men sometimes give freebees too to attract their customers. They are propagating their so-called divine products through modern media even though they are silly and cheap.

The genuine wise people remain incognito, whereas the imitators are basking in publicity. The people, who frequent these so-called religious God Men will soon get vexed and

disappointed. They will again search for a new one, who will be more liberal, attractive, acceptable, and cheaper. The duplication and imitation in the field of Religions and Spirituality are rampant, because the position of Religious God Men has brought the highest status people to the common folks to their feet, at their command. When popular brands of ordinary consumer products could be duplicated for earning a few extra currencies, how can the position like God Men be left alone?

Anyhow, these so-called Religious God Men's ways of life alert a few intelligent followers of them. The alert seekers understand these God Men's duplicity in course of time. They would come out of the grip of God Men soon, but there are still a lot of simpletons, who would become insane by practicing the ill-advised methods prescribed by these so-called God Men. On seeing the sufferings of such people, one may like to warn "Beware of such Religious God Men".

There are simple and straight forward ways to attain the association of genuine wise people, who could guide people in Life and to God. They

have been prescribed by the wise people. 'One should try to love all. One should avoid hatred feeling towards anybody. One should lead simple and contented life. One should not be greedy. One should not desire for others' property. One should work hard for one's bread in an honest way. One should always be helpful to others. One should not beg anything from anybody. One should prepare to sacrifice everything one has. One should know how to be alone and how to probe. They should also keep their body fit and alert by doing regular fasting. There should be sincere longing and searching for the Truth. They should have the burning aspiration to realize God. They should be fearless and with no demands for personal gains.'

If people can do all these things spontaneously, they do not have the need to search for the genuine wise people. Instead, the wise people will seek such people. The wise people will create unique situations in the lives of these privileged people and the same will enable the latter to reach the holy feet of wise people.

These eligible people are really blessed because in due course they will be one with God by the grace of wise people. In the anthropology, the evolution from the state of normal human beings to the state of wise people happens slowly, but surely it is going on. In their own mysterious ways, the incognito wise people of this world are constantly working for this evolution to happen among all people of this beautiful world.

## **2. Birth of Religions and Rituals**

Since from the time immemorial, both the religionists and scientists try to explain the human origin, but none could reach the definite conclusion with concrete evidence.

Some of the religionists say the mankind is the direct descendant of God. universe is the result of a mysterious big bang. From both sides there are mere assumptions and theories, which do not support the theory of the human origin beyond any doubts. The origin of Earth and its life remains a great mystery.

Millions of years ago the planet Earth was a fire ball separated from the Sun due to an impact of a great, mysterious force, as per the Scientists version. The formation of Earth, its cool down, its gravitational force, its self-rotation as well as its rotation around the Sun in the same path, the energy of the Sun, the configuration of air (Oxygen) and water, these all have caused and originated life on Earth, the Scientists say.

The fire ball Earth got cool down after millions of years. The glaciers were formed. Oxygen pervaded upon Earth. Water appeared on the surface of Earth. The combination of the five basic life sustaining elements, Earth, Air, Fire, Water, and the Ether created tiny life forces. The tiny life forces were evolved into different manifestations like plants, worms, birds, animals, and finally human beings according to some

rational thinkers and Scientists. But nobody could answer how the Sun was formed.

They say there are lots of similar Sun Families in the Milky-Way and even beyond it. They say there is constant formation of new Milky-Ways that contains Stars like Sun, even bigger and hotter than the Sun. What is the cause and which energy is causing these creations, none can answer.

The immense emptiness of the sky in which the innumerable cosmos exist, appears to be inactive, but the scientists observe that there are continuous activities happening in the sky beyond our perception. There happens creation of life forces somewhere in the Universe. There is an evolution of life going on in some other places in the Universe. The destruction and disappearance of life also happens somewhere in the Universe. Finally, we could conclude that the formation, evolution and destruction of everything is due to an amazing, mysterious and continuous action of an Unknown Supreme Energy that baffles even the advanced, developed

human intellects of both Scientists and Religionists.

They say the Earth got cool down after millions of years. There was heavy downpour that cooled down Earth. Initially, small portion of Earth was covered with water. Several thousands of years later, most area of Earth was submerged by the salty ocean. Severe earthquakes triggered volcanoes and tsunamis, which had gradually shaped Earth according to the present-day world map. Glaciers formed on the high-altitude mountains. Perennial rivers gushed out from them. The growth of dense forests on the slopes of the hills and mountains, rich soil formation on the banks of the rivers, the expansion of the dry and hot deserts and the creation of the sandy seashores with high velocity winds that all had enabled several species of creatures and mankind to exist.

The physical features of the plants, trees, animals, birds, and human beings have evolved into the present forms that have enabled them to survive on in different environments. After a lot of time, humans progressed further with their own languages, cultures and beliefs. The human history goes in this way according to some rational thinkers and Scientists as well as a few religionists too.

The wise people have asked the mankind to observe the existence of everything around us. They also have taught us to live in harmony with the Nature and other fellow beings so that the Earth could be the paradise for all. They say it is impossible for the limited and conditioned intelligence of human beings to comprehend the infinite process of creation, sustenance, and destruction. They declare that the conditioned human intelligence could never find out the origin of cosmos, which envelopes our Earth too.

The contents of cosmos are very much within every existing life on Earth, they say. They further proclaim if one could realize one's own 'self', there is the possibility of finding out the origin of the life force, which is infinite and pure. The wise people address this holy energy that has caused all existences, as Father, Almighty, God, and still in several other Names.

***(The present-day archaeologists claim that they have discovered several civilizations, existed thousands of years ago. They have excavated the structures and materials that had been used by the then existed people, below the frozen ice, in deep seabed, in dense forests and in rocky and sandy deserts around the world, but none have the interest to explore the role of the wise people, who had seen God and shared the divine wisdom with the mankind. The tradition of the wise people still has the continuation, will ever be continuing for the welfare of the whole existence.)***

The ancient human "Mammals" lived in groups. They hunted animals and birds for their food. They dwelled in the caves of the hills and

mountains. They covered their bodies with the dried skins of animals they hunted, to get protection from the cold, heat, and dust. It took thousands of years for the human beings to learn the usage of fire and pots. Gradually after lot of years they learned to breed cattle. Thousands of years later they learned to cultivate food grains, vegetables, and pulses.

There were several human groups living in the areas where they could get plenty of food. Like any other animal, humans also bordered their places and protected their areas. They learned to build huts to dwell within the border of their territory. The various groups considered each other as their competitor and enemy. So, if any group transgressed other group's territory, then, there would be war. The war was deadly, and the killing was considered as a heroic act.

The physically strong men with great valour were the leaders of the groups. The leader got the best of everything, whether it was food or girl. The men, women, children, and cattle were all the property of the leader, who was later called King. The king with the help of his confidential

assistants formatted rules and regulations. The subjects of the kingdom should follow the rules. They should obey and serve the king. The rebellions were tortured and executed without mercy.

When the group was not able to find out enough food and water within their boundaries for the ever-growing population, the King had to migrate with his subjects in search of better place, where food and water would be available sufficiently. To occupy better places, different groups fought each other. There were lots of casualties in both sides. The losers would either flee or become the slaves of the winners. Such the slavery system was formed. The slaves should work hard for the victorious king and his subjects in all means. The slaves had no freedom, and they should not demand anything. The remains of the food were thrown at them. Most of the slaves died due to hunger and lack of shelter in the extreme climates.

During that Stone Age period, love, care, and concern for fellow beings had not dawn on people. The survival of the self was important.

They survived, but not lived. The discriminating capacity of good and bad was totally absent. Searching for food, water and shelter was the only work they had. Men and women when they felt natural urge, shared their beds irrespective of the relationships and age differences. If there were more men vying for one woman, then there would be a dogfight among the men. The winner enjoyed the right to possess the woman. The losers would either be killed or forced to run away to die in isolation. The women's choice and emotions had no place in the male dominated groups. The children born to them were grown in the same way their elders lived.

It took thousands of years for human to evolve from caves to huts, from stones to metal and from raw meat to cooked food. They also gradually learned to make yarn from the wool collected from their cattle and weave cloth. They learned to make yarn and weave cloth from cotton later. They covered their body with coarse cloths made in wool and cotton. Thousands of years later, they were able to design their dresses in the more fashionable ways.



The people, who were least bothered about food for tomorrows, found sufficient time to observe, think and understand. They were different from the other common people. They were contended with the available food for quenching their appetite. Their thoughts were about the Nature and the welfare of the fellow beings. They were respected and called “Wise People.” They were the people, who had invented the ways of communication to share their observations, thinking and understanding.

Gradually different languages were created and evolved by the different human groups at various places on Earth. The formations of languages were because of the tireless works of a few wise individuals. Until then the human’s nature and character were like animals. They didn’t have the trust on others. With the help of the languages and wise people the thought process switched on. They were able to observe the lives of others. They gradually learned to feel others pains and sufferings. They realized the value of love and service to the fellow beings and other creatures. Slowly they were able to see the good and bad. At last, the sixth sense of discrimination had

dawned on human beings. The evolution progressed further. Eventually love, trust and sharing came into existence among the mankind. Such the nature of human was gradually transformed from the character of animals by the continuous works of the great wise people.

Some of the wise people of those periods developed small instruments that were useful in the daily life. Those instruments reduced human labour considerably in the daily life. The people could handle those instruments easily. Some wise people of later years taught people to tame wild horses and bulls and use them in their farms. They also trained people in horse riding to cover the distance. They designed carts pulled by horses and bulls. They formed cattle comprising of wild cows and goats. They befriended wild dogs and used them to guard people and hunt small animals. They invented new weapons to defend themselves from the wild animals and enemies. They also used those weapons to hunt animals. So far, the people had used sharp edged stones tied in strong wooden sticks to hunt animals and fight enemies. Slowly, after lot of trial and error, they could make weapons like

bow and arrows, spears and several other sharp-edged weapons made in wood. They discovered the usage of metals after very long time. Variety of weapons and tools were produced in metals after thousands of years. Almost all the new inventions were designed and built by the wise people of those periods.

The wise people invented strong building structures to get protection from the extreme climates, enemies, and wild animals. They searched for medicinal plants that could cure the wounds caused by wild animals, wars, and accidents. They found herbs to cure poisonous bites and several other ailments too. On trial and error, they discovered several useful herbal plants for different ailments. The wise people of all times had valued and revered Mother Nature. They were able to be one with Nature and so it was very easy for them to identify and locate the right herbal plants for different ailments. Sufferings of sick people induced love, care and concern in others' hearts. Thus, the evolution progressed further in the history of human.

So far, the immobile sick persons were left alone to die and became the prey for the wild animals and vultures. Later, after the dawn of some intelligence, they laid the immobile dying persons with some food and water on the cliffs of hills, where the wild animals could not climb. The dying persons suffered with cruel pain due to the diseases or wounds. After their death, vultures and other birds tasted the human flesh.

Centuries later, humans learned to bury the dead persons with their belongings. They put the dead bodies with their personal belongings in big mud pots and buried them. Some of the human cults found new ways to dispose the dead bodies. They burnt the dead bodies with dry wood. Some other groups tried to preserve the dead bodies of important personalities with their personal belongings. They applied some natural preservatives upon the dead bodies. They covered the dead bodies tightly with the then available animals' skins and put the same in wooden boxes. They kept the wooden boxes in specific places within their territory and built monuments on them to show their respect on the dead.

After the discovery of herbs, the life span of human beings was enhanced. The herbal treatment is still being used in some parts of the world for various diseases and poisonous bites. The herbal treatment seems to be effective in some cases even now.

The human intelligence grew gradually. They were able to think creatively. Even then they were helpless during the crisis times of war, drought, sickness, wildfire, violent burst of volcanoes, cyclones, cloudburst, floods, frequent fall of huge meteorites and earthquakes. They perished in large numbers in the natural calamities and a few alone could escape from the nature's wrath. They didn't know how to protect themselves. They felt the need of an extraordinary powerful being's help, protection, and support.

A few human minds had thought of an all powerful being that could protect them and save them from the natural calamities, diseases, wild animals, and enemies. They imagined and produced amazing forms of Gods. They believed

those Gods would save them. Thus, the theory of God was invented. (Earlier Sun, Moon, Stars, Fire, Hills, Mountains, Big Trees and Rivers were considered mysterious and divine.) The Gods of those time were terrific and in gigantic forms. The Gods had several heads and hands holding terrifying weapons. Those forms of Gods were sculpted in stones and woods. The inventors of Gods created rituals too to worship those Gods. Whenever they faced crisis, they imagined, God was angry with them. So, they sacrificed animals, sometimes human too to pacify Gods. The inventor of Gods and rituals became the priests rather God Men later.

The so-called God Men were gradually able to understand the power, capability and capacity of their minds. They were also able to discover certain mental and physical exercises, which led them to occult powers. They practiced them with great audacity for long time. Such rigorous exercises enabled them to attain mysterious occult powers through which they could materialize several things from nowhere. When the mind was totally one with the object, the



object could be materialized in front of the mesmerized people.

The God Men walked on fire. They appeared and disappeared from the sight of the common people at their will. The mysterious magic baffled people. The power of mind that was attained through the rigorous exercises was described as the power of God. The people believed that God had descended on the so-called God Men and performed the miracles through the latter. The people were afraid of those God Men possessing occult powers. The horrified people bowed down before the God Men with fear and reverence. They obeyed God Men and did whatever the latter commanded.

The reverence of the common people for God Men corrupted the latter. The God Men became highly egoistic because of the adoration of the people. Encouraged by the reverence, they started dictating people according to the whim of their fanciful thoughts. They wanted everyone to believe them, obey them and serve them with reverence. If anybody questioned their authority, the questioner would be sacrificed at the altar of

God. The God Men became so cruel, and witchcraft became the part of their lives. They used their occult powers to terrorize people to establish their authority on the society. Thus, evil forces came into existence in the name of God.

On the other hand, the wise people not at all bothered about the occult powers. The occult powers and still more divine capabilities blossomed in them so naturally with all the beauty because of their oneness with the Mother Nature. Whatever they pronounced happened instantly. People got benefited by their miracles. The wise people healed the diseases of people by their mystic touch. They were able to foresee the natural calamities and shifted people to the safer places. The whole nature and elements of cosmos were at their disposal. They had absolute knowledge of Nature's Laws. They used their graceful powers for the welfare of all living beings. They never used their wonderful powers for their own benefits, comforts, and protection.

Unlike the wise people, the so-called God Men used their occult powers for their personal benefits. They terrorized people through their

occult powers to consolidate their position in the society. They became the second authoritative, next to the Kings. To attain more power and to gain more reverence from the common people, they practiced several silly and cruel rituals, which were nothing but the outcome of the irrational and insane minds. Torturing and sacrificing animals and humans at the altar of their Gods was one among the rituals that had been believed to bring them fame, security, and prosperity.

The different groups that had performed the almost same cruel rituals to worship the terrifying forms of Gods, in due course, merged with one another and developed into cults. Thousands of similar cults were formed on this Earth, but all such cults were vanished from Earth by the constant and tireless works of a few noble, wise individuals of later periods. The wise people substituted the inhuman rituals with the real virtues of life that consisted of love, concern, and Truth. Sometimes the wise people had to fight wars to eradicate the extreme evil cults to protect humanity.



From the Stone Age period to the present-day civilizations, only a few individuals discovered, invented and created useful things for further advancement of mankind. Those wise people's discoveries had eased the human labour in the daily life. The common people finally could find time to think and enquire about God. This irked the so-called God Men. If people would begin to think and understand the power of mind, then their position in the society would become vulnerable, they feared. So, they ill treated the selfless, great wise people, who encouraged the common people to think and probe.

Sometimes they ordered to kill the wise. The noble wise people were labelled as sinners by the so-called God Men. The God Men declared that the wise people were working against the will of God and so they should be killed. The people should not use the new inventions of wise, the God Men ordered. The people out of fear obeyed God Men.

It took lot of years for the wise men's discoveries to gain acceptance in the society. Later after long time, the people of all sects realized the value and

need of those great wise people's discoveries. All the scientific discoveries have emerged not through, but despite and amid the oppression of the organized cults and religions.

The wise people developed languages, music, poetry, dance, medicines, drawing, sculpting, architecture, sciences, astronomy, and still other useful things for the development of mankind. Several musical instruments were designed and created by wise people. They learned to play them to express their joy, devotion, and sorrows. They trained others too to make and play musical instruments. The classical music and its branches became the part and parcel of human culture. The wise people made use of the music to impart the divine wisdom to the mankind. It all happened over thousands of years.

The wise people who were well versed in astronomy, calculated the movements of earth and formatted time, days, months, and years. The present-day time machine and calendars are the result of the tireless works of the wise people.

The wise people found that love and peace was generated in their beings while they were absolutely in solitude and one with the whole Nature. They perceived the reality of life and mystery of God. They got enlightened and taught people the greatness of love and service. They dedicated their whole life for the welfare of their fellow beings. They also shouldered the responsibility to guide people towards God. They composed poems of devotion and philosophy. They chanted them before their group of people. They found it easy to penetrate and impress people's hearts through those songs. All the wise people across the world have great love to listen to the melodious songs that glorify God and express love.

Unlike the so-called God Men, the ancient wise people worked hard to initiate virtues in human life. They organized social structures among the masses. The social relationships were framed by them. They not only discriminated good and bad deeds, but also taught people that good deeds would bestow joy and peace and bad deeds would result in pain and sufferings.

The human life was transformed by the revolutionary preaching of wise people. The teachings got more sophistication according to the evolution of humans. Earlier the wise people encouraged mankind to enquire about life and God. On those days the serious seekers among the common people had doubts and questions. They were allowed by the wise people to enquire and ask questions to clear their doubts. The wise people enjoyed the company of such serious seekers. They would patiently answer the questions and enlighten the seekers.

But nowadays questioning is sin. Enquiring is blasphemy. One has no right to question. They should follow the authoritarian God Men, Religions, and its beliefs unconditionally, without hesitation. Followers alone are the devotees of God and the people who question are traitors to God and religions! It is always the attitude of all religions and its organizers. Contemplation and enquiry have no place in the religions. The people should believe and submissive to the ritualistic religious beliefs, otherwise they would be labelled as nonbelievers, atheists.

The wise people's simple, serene way of life and their graceful preaching on life and God attracted and transformed people in an amazing magnitude. The wise people were in total freedom and respected others freedom. They encouraged people to ask their doubts and cleared them. Whereas the religious bigheads asked people to obey and follow, the wise people allowed people to question and probe till the people discovered the Truth by themselves.

The ritualistic so-called God Men were not able to understand the wise people's thinking and its values. They doubted about the intention of wise people. They thought that the wise people would degrade and destroy their position in the society. So, they were furious with wise people. But at the same time, they were also frightened on seeing the natural and amazing divine powers of wise people. They were fuming with jealous over the growing popularity of wise people among their citizens.

The growing fame of wise people enraged the so-called religious God Men. On seeing the revolutionary transformation among the people,

the furious God Men wanted to stop the wise people's activities. The wise people were love personification and they lived and worked for the betterment of whole fellow beings.

In contrast, the so-called God Men were selfish, and they cared only about their own concepts, comforts, authority, security, popularity, and pleasures. They did not do anything to dignify human life. They were not able to contribute anything to benefit the society. They wanted to establish only their authority. They gave false hopes and wanted people to believe them. Whereas the wise people cared for their fellow beings and contributed great useful things to the mankind, the so-called religious God Men whiled away their time in sensual pleasures and tried to win over Gods and mankind by their silly religious beliefs and rituals.

The beliefs and rituals couldn't help people to get rid of their pains and problems. So, the people diverted their attention towards wise people and their teachings. The teachings gave solace to everyone and gradually the common people started adoring the wise. Slowly the whole

society was about to slip from the God Men's grip. The God Men felt that it should be prevented at any cost. They warned people not to follow the wise. They tried in all possible ways to prevent people listening to the wise. They threatened people in the name of God. But they couldn't stop everyone.

There were a few courageous and virtuous people. They listened to the wise people and applied the teachings in their life leaving behind the religious beliefs. It shocked the God Men. The wise and the courageous virtuous people became the nightmare for the God Men. The cult of God Men, out of fear, threatened wise people and their audience with dire consequences. They announced severe strictures against wise people and ordered them not to talk about God and virtues of life. They also commanded wise people not to condemn their cults, beliefs, and rituals.

The wise people had no fear by nature, and they didn't care about the threats of God Men. They carried on their works with the same vigour as usual. The God Men finally declared that the wise people were the traitors of their cults and Gods.

They also accused the wise people that the latter were working against the will of God. They prosecuted wise people and pronounced death sentences. They persecuted and killed the wise people.

The wise people sometimes used their divine powers to come out of the savage attempts to instil faith in the hearts of common people, but most of the time they opted to be vulnerable despite the extraordinary divine power they had. They suffered and died at the cruel hands of the insensitive, authoritative Religious God Men. The wise people had used even their death to teach and transform people.

Even though the great sacrifice of wise people had awakened the mankind, soon after the death of wise people, the common people, except a few, again restored to their previous ritualistic life of their cults. They had been constantly threatened by the authoritative, oppressive, and aggressive God Men. Once again, the ritualistic religious beliefs recovered from the fall.

Even then there were some brave, intelligent individuals, who sincerely adopted and applied the teachings of wise people in their lives. The traditions of these small groups of good people have their continuity, but it has remained incognito forever. The tradition of such great devotees is visible and accessible to only a few eligible seekers.

The beliefs, rather superstitions and its rituals of all the ancient cults, in due course vanished miraculously from the Earth. The falsehood could not last long. Brilliant intelligence was blossomed by the grace of wise people and the new era dawned on mankind. The great thinking based on love and selfless service, at last, blossomed in the hearts of people due to the immense sacrifice and compassion of wise people.

The holy tradition of wise people continued and contributed selfless love, virtues of life and the goal of human being, "GOD" to the mankind. Those wise people lived pure, selfless, compassionate, and graceful life that had sanctified the whole earth. Their lives became

great inspiration and their teachings helped people to have the dignified life in the world.

All the present-day religions were formed, based on the teachings of the great wise people after their demise. The wise people, on whose teachings the present-day religions have been established, did not belong to any other earlier cults, religions, or establishments. They were the rebellions of the earlier cults and religions, which were founded on the wrong concepts and silly rituals.

The wise people saw God alone. That's why they are called Seers. They emerged successfully in being one with the Supreme God, not through any religious practices and rituals, but despite them. They attained the supreme state by constantly remembering God. They never had announced that they had founded religions. They, with all compassion, talked only about Truth, Truth alone that could save people from the social turmoil and unite them with God.

The people who had associations with those wise people tried to propagate and organize the

teachings among the multitudes. They glorified their Masters and worshipped the latter with unusual rituals. Finally, it's all ended in the formation of Religions. The founders of Religions worked hard in compiling and propagating the teachings of wise people. They chanted the teachings and gave discourses to the common people explaining the subtle meanings of the teachings. Lot of admirers followed those religions.

*(There was an ancient, civilized group of great wise people that had discovered the origin of cosmos, life and God. Those great wise people lived in tune with God and guided people to understand life and God. The people of later years compiled the teachings of those unknown wise people and started practicing and preaching the same to the people. Later, certain groups of people attempted to possess them. They organized the ways of learning and practicing the works of wise people. It ended in the formation of several cults. Some wise people of later years attempted to merge all the cults to unite people, but their very attempts were organized later after their demise. The process ended in the formation of religion with*

*multiple cults. In due course, several beliefs, concepts, and rituals were added to strengthen this religion and its cults. Lot of worshipping places were also built later to uphold the beliefs and rituals of this religion.)*

In due course the founders died. Many claimed the posts of successors of those founders. They wanted to take the reins of religious institutions. They passionately desired to get more prominence and popularity among people than their predecessors. They had clashes among themselves and treated one another as their competitor.

The fervent longing for name and fame from the swelling crowd of their religions made them unstable. They imagined that they had achieved great spiritual state than other competitors and expected people to bow and worship their personal charisma. They erroneously elaborated the teachings of wise people to win over the confidence of common folks. They gave their own sensational interpretations to the teachings to attract still more crowd.

The successors tried numerous ways to attract masses for their sect. Initially they preached the plain teachings of wise people. Later due to the competition and envy among themselves, they added new concepts and techniques quite contrary to the teachings of wise people. They built worshipping places for their religions. They succeeded in attracting the bulk of multitudes for their sects.

In due course they imagined that they alone could carry on with the divine works of wise people. Their self-projections strengthened their ego and boosted their pride. The ego developed fear and needed security and continuity. To protect their social status and pride, they invented and developed still more beliefs and techniques. In such ways they tried to impress their followers and establish themselves unshakably in their religions. All their selfish activities had went against the teachings of wise people.

The successors created symbols and images to strengthen their new beliefs and techniques. To the astonishment of sensible people, even the

deadly instruments that had killed the wise people became the Holy Symbol. The outcome of the extreme, culpable human imagination had become the Holy Symbol. Such Holy Symbols had become vital for their religious organizations and worshipping places.

The successors advised people to respect and revere the symbols. They formatted rituals to worship the symbols in their worshipping places. They instructed people to conduct those rituals reverentially and regularly. Those who refused to accept the religious disciplines were labelled as traitors and were isolated.

The religions, its symbols, the amusing beliefs, and rituals became more important than the wise people and their teachings. To attain cheap popularity, the successors didn't hesitate even to hurt the real seekers and devotees, who had not bothered about the beliefs and rituals of religions.

In due course the successors died. But before that they had done enough damage to the teachings of wise people. The religious beliefs, disciplines and

rituals that were invented by the successors, were strengthened by their followers. The followers of the successors propagated new beliefs and rituals to become still more popular and prominent in the society. Their religious status gave them enormous wealth, comforts, dignity, power, and authority.

The wise people's teachings were all about God, love, selfless service and eradicating the 'self'. Their teachings were to shun power, authority, and violence, but in the process of organizing the teachings of wise people, all the unwanted sects, rituals, craze for power, authority and violent conflicts rose among the people. The wise people all over the world constantly worked to unite people in God, whereas the religions that had been created on the teachings of the same wise people divided mankind and caused violence in the name of God. It is painfully true.

The wise people knew that God could never be organized, but the religions that had been founded on the teachings of the same wise people constantly try to possess and organize God. One could live in God by merging himself in God but

could never keep God in his possession and organize.

The founders of the religions, their successors and their followers had powerful and dramatic styles to run their religions and its worshipping places. The different successors and their followers strengthened their beliefs by adding additional concepts and rituals. In due course such beliefs divided the society and formed powerful divisions of religions, which were named differently. Every division of religions declared that they were the supreme and real and all other divisions were false and unreal.

The divisions among religions caused enmity that resulted in violent conflicts. To uphold their beliefs, they fought among themselves and killed each other in the name of God. Their worshipping places were also destroyed in the wars. They referred this senseless fighting as “Holy War”. The wise people sacrificed their lives for the sake of Love and God, but the followers of those great wise people sacrificed the wise people and God for the sake of their beliefs and organizations.

The whole process of religions is like a river, which springs so gently and so pure out of the melting glazier of high altitude. Multiple springs form a stream. Several streams join and get the shape of a river. The river gets momentum and descends with great current from the higher altitude to the plains with little lesser purity but with great beauty. When the river reaches the plains, the purity of river is alarmingly contaminated with the dirt and wastes of humans, animals, and industries. And once it merges into ocean, it becomes salty and is unfit to consume, but still one can find valuable pearls and other precious stones in the deep bed of salty ocean. Similarly, one can rarely find wise people in the religious garbs.

A few rare, intelligent, and compassionate people, who are immersed in the teachings of wise people, choose to live in solitude, in secluded places, away from the society, its religions, rituals and the institutions. They contemplate the teachings of wise people and silently remember the latter. Their sincere efforts and passionate search would reward them with 'Self Realization' and they would become one with wise people,



God. They radiate love, compassion, and divinity. Some of them come out of their solitude and start living among people. They teach people the way to Supreme God through their simple, wise words and great lives. Even though some of them wear religious garbs they are beyond the limitations of religions. They never argue with their religious friends. They know, God and Truth cannot be argued or debated.

The 'Self Realized' people have done great services to the humanity and radiated peace, bliss, and harmony. The tradition of 'Self Realized' People has its incognito continuity and would be visible only for those who seek the Truth or God. It is amazing to see the fact that none of the names of the inventors of religions and their rituals are remembered or mentioned in any religious records or spiritual works, but most of the non-ritualistic, compassionate, great, wise and 'Self Realized' divine people's names are mentioned and remembered in every religious, historical, and spiritual works throughout the world.

Some of the names of the simple, realistic, and great divine 'Self Realized' people are still in the hearts of people, even though the people do not know and practice their teachings in their lives. At the same time the names and the identity of the creators of religions and their rituals are conveniently forgotten even though the people are following the religious disciplines and doing the prescribed rituals out of fear and sufferings.

The people who conduct religious rituals do not know that God is omnipotent, omnipresent, and omniscient. God can never be influenced by offering and flattering. God cannot be cajoled. God alone is eternal. The good and bad events in the human life are nothing but the outcome of the deeds that have been done in the daily life. Good deeds bring happiness and bad deeds bring pains and problems at the appropriate time.

The disease, decaying of the physic, affecting by natural calamities, accidents, aging and death, these all should not be considered as bad things. At the same time beauty, health, long life, money, intelligence, status in the society, recognition, power, and authority should not be considered as

good things either because both are transient and illusionary. That's why the wise people have taught that one should transcend the concepts of both the good and bad to attain God and realize Truth.

The self-proclaimed God Men never bother about the people's inborn nature, character, desires, and deeds. They do not have the capability either to penetrate the human hearts or perceive their real desires and sorrows. The so-called God Men repeat the same words and phrases of wise people in all circumstances, but without care, concern, wisdom, and love. They emphasize certain rituals in their worshipping places as the remedy for the day-to-day problems. These rituals, of course, help to strengthen the people's 'self', but never could erase the 'self'.

The people do not aware that the root cause for their pains and problems is the same 'self', because the 'self' is nothing but a bundle of desires. By doing the rituals, the 'self' imagines that it has satisfied God, but, within a short period, it realizes that it is only an emotional hallucination. Gradually the 'self' gets vexed and

tired. Involuntarily the 'self' resorts to its old habits. It pursues the pleasures and fears the consequent pains. It uses God and Religion in utter selfishness for its day-to-day function. There ego develops again and gets strengthened.

Whenever such egoists are amid the religious congregations they pretend as if they have attained the wholeness of life and understood all the secrets of life and death. In due course it becomes their way of life. This dishonest behaviour prevents human to learn further about Life and God. Observing the 'self' and understanding the same would bring the needed transformation and this great transformation leads one to God. The self-observation is possible only through the association and guidance of wise people. The people, who do not have the guidance of wise people, cannot understand, and eradicate their 'self' and have the wisdom of God.

Sometimes the religious beliefs and rituals take its toll by making the ambitious self-projecting people dangerously insane and destroy their lives. These beliefs and rituals damage their inborn natural thinking mechanism and cause

havoc in their life, which would affect their immediate surroundings as well as the society.

To achieve cheap popularity, the arrogant, fanatic religious bigheads, preach silly beliefs and rituals and apply psychological pressure on the people to follow their teachings. They cunningly cultivate fear among the common people by projecting hell after death and pain in the present life. They also assure awards like heaven, fame, and comforts for the obedient followers. They almost have destroyed the people's natural intelligence. However, these religious bigheads' names will never be in the human history. Its God's compassionate grace, the names of Great Seers alone will ever be in the minds of people.

### **3. The Languages**

Every creature on Earth has a mode of communication. Long before the invention and usage of languages, the ancient human beings had the distinct way of communication. Initially they produced sounds with different emotions and gestured to communicate information about the happenings. They expressed their love, joy, desire, revulsion, fear, pain, sorrow, disappointments, satisfaction and still several other emotions through the gestures and sounds.

Gradually they advanced further. They developed their skill to pass on the most important information with one another by drawing pictures and producing meaningful sounds. They used their fingers and sticks to draw pictures on sand to convey the emergency news. On those days the most important and urgent information was the sight of enemies or the new arrival of animals in their areas. The information was passed on by such drawings through which the people understood the situations and acted accordingly.



During their leisure time they drew pictures on the walls of the caves they dwelled, whatever they had seen during their day out in search of food. It seems that they had attempted to convey their experiences to their fellow beings. They used coloured extracts from certain plants to draw pictures.

The combination of sounds and gestures helped in the information flow among the ancient people. The frequent usages of such combinations were the seeds of the languages. In due course the initial sounds that were used frequently in particular situations took the shape of words. One by one new words were added and slowly the present-day languages were formed.

Everything was named. The plants, birds, animals, human race, everything that had existed, were named. The languages are the prime instruments for the development of thoughts, intelligence, knowledge, and wisdom.

Once the language took shape, the wise people among the group tried to get it written. The wise

people formatted scripts starting right from the alphabets. Their skill to develop both the scripts and numerical counts is amazing. They framed grammar for the languages. The scripts of all languages were improved gradually and finally we can use the present-day well-developed scripts.

It took thousands of years to have one fully developed language. Even though the shape of scripts were slowly developed and changed according to the convenience of people, the pronunciation of words remained the same. However, much later, the talking language became different from the writing one. When the language is being written it would be grammatical, but while talking nobody bothers about grammar.

Constructive thinking, exchange of information, expression of emotions, knowledge, intelligence, wisdom, and religions were all possible for the human beings only after the formation of languages. The present day modern human life is because of the languages. If there is no language, there could be no invention, no discovery, no

development, and no dignified and comfortable life at all.

The whole credit for the creation of the present day languages should go to those unknown divine wise people of the world. Earlier, different cult created different languages. Most of the languages withered away due to the oppression of the other dominant groups. At the times of wars, the mighty, violent groups destroyed their opponent army, looted the common people, and abducted the young women.

They also attempted to erase the losers' beliefs, cultures, religions, and languages by insulting and prohibiting them. They even demolished the worshipping places of the losers in the wars. They built their own religious worshipping places either on the ruins of the earlier worshipping places or adjacent to them. The victorious groups enforced their own beliefs, cultures, religions, and languages on the defeated groups. Sometimes the languages of both the groups got mixed and took a new shape.

Most of the ancient languages did not have the scripts. Only the groups which had wise people

among them were able to create scripts for their languages. The wise people needed plain surface on which they could write the scripts. Initially they used sharp edged stones to carve pictures on the rough surface of rocky walls of their dwelling caves. Later they drew pictures on the walls with the coloured extracts of certain plants.

Lot of years later they learned to write with the sharp-edged twigs on the hardest plain surface of the dried thick leaves. Some of the wise people found palm leaves were suitable for writing and storing. They cut the palm leaves to size, so that they could easily write on them. The sharp-edged twigs made an impression on the dried leaves that was visible and readable. In due course the twigs were replaced with the sharp-edged metal.

Later after long-time metal plates were used as paper. The people on those days engraved the important documents on the surface of the metal plates. This progress developed further. The present-day paper, pen and printing are the result of the consistent development of mankind that was mainly contributed by a few noble enthusiastic wise people.

In the human evolution, only some groups excelled in technology. They used their languages and achieved great results in all the fields of life. They designed and built big yachts, which could sail by wind power as well as by rowing to cross mighty oceans. They reached new places on the other shores. In due course they loaded their merchandise in their big yachts and bravely sailed across rough seas in the hope of amassing fortunes.

Those advanced groups of people, who were able to sail months together in the rough sea, discovered several new countries in different continents. They interacted with the people living there and learned their languages too. They also mixed up several languages to conveniently communicate with those people. Some of such combinations later became very popular and useful languages. There are several such languages, which have been developed by the constant usage of masses of different countries.

The learned and advanced groups from the different parts of the world sailed vastly across

the ocean in search of new lands. They discovered some new undeveloped lands with its illiterate, half naked, dry, and dark-skinned vulnerable people. They caught them and forcibly made them their slaves to row their yachts and carry their merchandise.

Mostly the white skinned people thus started the slavery system. In due course the slaves too became one of the commodities of their merchandise. They sold the black slaves in many countries. This cruel slavery system was eradicated later by the great efforts of wise people. The wise people toiled over years and tried to bring equal status for all human beings. Now, one can see, many men and women of the past slave community occupy prestigious posts in those countries. The whole credit for this historical feat goes to the great wise people.

Initially there was the communication gap between the slaves and their Masters. The slaves had to learn their masters' languages and the masters also had to learn their slaves' mode of communication. In the process of learning one other's languages, both the languages got mixed

and a new form of language came into the existence. Such languages got new shape in course of time.

Nobody could claim that any language is pure and unadulterated. Some scholars have supported this notion. They claimed that the so called most ancient and holy language of this world was the mixture of three other popular languages of those period with its own basic substance.

The most advanced, apparently civilized, but brutal group of people of this world had spread their language around the world by invading and occupying other countries. They entered the other countries in the disguise of businesspeople and gradually captured those countries using all sorts of tricks, dirty politics and sometimes through wars.

They exploited the local people and looted their natural wealth. They treated the natives like slaves. They enforced their religions and languages on them. In this way the languages were mixed. The religious beliefs and rituals of

other local religions were also conveniently adopted by them. One can observe the present-day popular religions of this world having similar beliefs and rituals of the local religions. One can also see the present-day popular languages having the similar words of the local languages.

The wise people of every group across the world, particularly in Asia blossomed with extraordinary wisdom. They perceived the subtle aspects of Life, Death and God. They preached right royal paths to lead harmonious and divine life in the languages known to the common people. They taught people about Supreme God, creation of cosmos and the virtues of human life. They revealed the reality of Life and Death in the common local languages known to the masses.

The teachings in the common local languages were recorded by the disciples of wise people in other unique languages, which were not commonly used then for communication. Those languages might have been used only for writing, because probably they alone had the scripts on those times. The other common languages were used only to converse with one another in

general but were not used in writing because of the non-formation of scripts.

Whenever the disciples had the doubts and confusion, they would enquire their Masters in their mother tongue. The divine Masters patiently explained, quoting examples so that the disciples could understand the teachings properly. The disciples noted down the answers of their Masters and recorded them in those unique languages. The works of wise people were compiled in those languages. Sometimes the wise people themselves wrote down their works in those languages, even though they were not their mother tongue. Only learned elite people of the society were able to understand those languages.

The disciples of wise people memorized those divine works and practiced them. They also were instrumental in transmitting the holy works of wise people to the future generations. The people, who practiced the divine works, later started worshipping them with certain rituals. They formed cults. In the long run the cults developed into castes. The castes, which learned

those great works of wise people, imagined that they were superior to others.

The so-called superior caste people denied the opportunity to the other caste people to learn those languages in which the ancient wise people had poured their wisdom. The knowledge of the high valued teachings of wise people also was denied to the other caste people. They wanted to keep the knowledge secret so that they could gain reverence and social dignity from other caste people. In due course the knowledge they possessed comfortably earned them the easiest and convenient livelihood. The other caste people also showed no interest, nor did they have the time to learn those unique languages and gain the wisdom of wise people because of their struggle for the day-to-day basic needs of life.

The elders of the so-called superior caste people invented strange symbols and dress code that would help to identify them. They advised the members of their caste to wear them on their beings so that they could be differentiated from the other castes' people.

They also instructed people to add their caste name behind their names so that it would be easy to identify the caste of people. It became customary in some part of the world to call persons by addressing their castes names. In due course these customs and practices are reduced due to the great efforts of the wise people.

The upper caste people developed odd religious beliefs and conducted strange rituals, which had never been advocated by wise people. For every event in the life, from birth till death, they formatted rituals. They assured people that those rituals would bring good fortune to the believers. They also claimed that they alone had the qualifications to perform the rituals by chanting the works of wise people in those specific languages.

If suppose other caste people would do the same rituals, God would not accept it, God would not give the appropriate results and would get angry too, they threatened. The common people should offer them money and materials for the great services they rendered! Such the rituals became the livelihood for the upper caste people. They

didn't have the need to work manually for their bread.

The other caste people depended on the upper caste people to perform the religious and social rituals for their betterment. The dependence made the upper caste people highly egoistic. To establish and retain their high position in the society, they floated still more false beliefs among people so that the people would depend on them more and more to have extraordinary benefits. They propagated that they alone could communicate with God.

The innocent people believed them and showered great respect on them. It further strengthened the ego of the upper caste people. To ensure their elated position in the society, they treated other caste people as untouchables. They declared that they were holy because they were the direct descendent of God! All others were common insignificant creatures. So, the other caste people should keep respectable distance and should not go near the so-called upper caste people. This superiority complex of upper caste people caused serious social

imbalance that had also to be solved by the wise people.

Experiencing the humiliation at the hands of upper caste people, the other caste people treated their subordinate caste people in the same way. The untouchables were created by the principles of the so-called upper caste people. The upper caste people considered themselves pure and pious and all others were sinners. They had done great damage to the humanity by creating inequality and disharmony among people. If they would have educated the other caste people with the teachings of wise people of those times, equality, social harmony, and wisdom would have ever been with the whole human race. Disharmony and mistrust could have been averted among the present-day different castes and community. But, alas, due to the greedy nature of some small groups of people, the whole human race had to suffer.

These unwarranted practices of the upper caste and other castes people underwent sweeping changes in the later years. The upper caste people also were forced to work for their

livelihood. The great wise people amended certain conditions for the people, who desired to lead life in the name of God. The strict conditions terrified the easy-going upper caste people, as they were not able to meet out the conditions. They finally joined the mainstream of the society to work for their bread. But still, they claim that they belong to the upper caste!

However, there are still a few people, who abide by the amended conditions of wise people and adopt them in their daily life. Their life is pure and chaste. They remember God constantly and they live on their life only by the alms they get from the common people. They never crave for richness and comforts. They lead simple life. They live in tune with God. They sing and glorify God alone. They preach only about God and virtuous Life. They console the aching hearts and try to alleviate the sufferings of people by imparting the divine wisdom. These people could be called wise people despite their caste based religious appearances.

In mean time, several other common languages got their own scripts by the consistent efforts of

wise people existed then. Some other wise people rendered the teachings of ancient wise people which were in the unique, ancient language into the local common languages and made them available for all. Thus, the divine wisdom at last could reach the common people.

The wise people also authored the stories of chaste women and divine men in those common languages. They wrote songs glorifying God. The stories and songs that were written in those local common languages touched the hearts of mankind. They influenced people in great way. The common people took sincere efforts to lead a chaste divine life like the divine characters presented in the stories authored by the wise people.

Having seen the divine works of wise people in the local languages, the so-called upper caste people got angry. They didn't like the divine secrets became open to all. They couldn't tolerate the divine stories and philosophy put in the local, common languages. The upper caste people so far believed that the Gods and the right to teach people were their own. They didn't expect that

Divinity could be put before the common masses by the wise people in such a simple way. They felt their rights on God and teachings had been looted.

Initially they didn't bother much, but after they saw the masses turned their attention towards the wise people and their simple presentation of God and Divine Life in the common languages, they systematically tried to block the works of wise people. They opposed to the holy works and tried to prevent them getting familiar and popular among the masses. They even attempted to destroy them.

However, most of the divine works of wise people was saved mysteriously. The upper caste people threatened and sometimes persecuted the wise people to prevent them present their works to the common people. Even though there were the savage attacks on the wise people, the latter never reacted and retaliated against the upper caste people's stupid behaviors. They lived graceful life totally in tune with God and they didn't even try to defend themselves. The common people adored their way of life. They

revered them and glorified their works in the common local languages. They had immense faith on them and their works. They saw God in them.

Despite the adverse situations created by the religious oriented upper caste people, the wise people could not be stopped preaching the virtues of life and wisdom of God in the known, common languages to the masses. The wise people came again and again in different forms, from different castes and different places on Earth. They worked to eradicate the ignorance from the common people and enlighten the latter with their great works in the local common languages.

The wise people sometimes traveled to far off places to uplift the people there and enlighten them. The wise people learned the languages of those places that enabled them to do their divine works. Nowadays all the ancient divine works that were kept secret for ages have been translated into the common languages so that they could reach all people irrespective of genders, nationality, and castes.

The wise people of various places of the world have performed great revolutionary miracles to transform the common people. Their works and lives have awakened the less privileged people and initiated the eligible among the latter into divinity. They created Divine, God's Names. They preached people to chant God's Names with devotion and they assured that this simple devotion could take one to God.

The whole tradition of wise people from ancient time to till date, have invested their spiritual energy in these God's Names. By the influence of these great wise people, the less privileged people also could remember God's Names constantly and could finally realize God. It is evident that God alone has come in the forms of these great wise people. The whole mankind should salute these great wise souls, who have inculcated the wisdom of God into the human hearts irrespective of their castes, communities, nations, and genders with the help of the common, simple local languages.

## **4. The Basic Code Of conducts**

The ancient human settlements had been flourishing on the banks of perennial rivers, in the foothill of high-altitude mountains amidst dense forests, along seashores and in deserts with water resources. The people lived in groups in those places. In their long search for food and water, the ancient people searched vastly and discovered the above said places to settle down. There were stiff competition and fights among various groups of people to live in those comfortable places.

After very long time they were able to accommodate each other, side by side, by the serious efforts of wise people from both sides. They fixed borders for their groups. Every group had their own way of life. Their beliefs, Gods and languages were different from each other. The groups upheld their identity and protected their territory.

Gradually the people, who lived on the banks of perennial rivers learned to cultivate grains, fruits,

and vegetables. Earlier they caught wild dogs, horses, cows, and goats and made them domestic animals. They discovered the usage of fire. They developed their skill to make fire, which was essential for cooking and dispelling darkness during night. They built strong structures with baked bricks and stones and lived in those houses.

The comfortable houses protected them from the extreme climatic conditions. They built huge forts around their settlement to prevent enemies entering their town. They grazed their cattle along the river side forests and meadows. They drank the milk of cows and goats. They consumed their meat too.

Somewhere the people revered the cows and other animals. Some of the groups later gave up the habit of eating meat of animals and birds, which they considered divine, but they ate fish. The fish was available in plenty in the nearby rivers and ponds. They discovered various techniques of fishing.

Some of the groups started living strict vegetarian even giving up eating fishes after having cultivated grains and vegetables. All the groups developed their skill to make pots in which they cooked their food as well as stored water and other essentials. They learned to grind the grains and bake them.

Generally, the people of those times ate baked grain powder along with cooked vegetables, fish and meat. They consumed various tasty fruits also. Finally, the mankind evolved to prepare and consume the well-balanced healthy food. It took thousands of years for this evolution to happen. The food grains, (particularly wheat and rice) vegetables, fruits, fish, meat, milk, and milk products provided wholesome and healthy diet for them.

The wise people of all groups greatly influenced mankind to have healthy food habit that would keep them physically fit. The food habit was formulated according to the climatic conditions of the region and the availability of the ingredients for the food.

Anyhow the wise people gave more importance to the words that coming out of the mouths of people rather than the food going inside their mouth. They emphasized that the words should be soothing, loving, comfortable, wise, kind and consoling. They effectively preached that the words people used should bring forth harmony, wisdom, and trust among people.

The other groups that lived in forests, in deserts and on the seashores also improved their lifestyle by utilizing the locally available products. The growth of population in all groups swelled at alarming rate and forced them to migrate from place to place in search of sufficient food and water. Various groups fought each other for the comfortable dwelling places. The mighty got the better places and the weak should be away from them. Even though every group appeared to be different in their way of life, all their needs and emotions were the same. They had their own set of wise people among them.

The wise people of every group discovered many useful things that eased the life of people. The groups gradually met with each other in good

terms. Their acquaintance bred friendship and affinity. They also started exchanging their products for mutual betterment. The wise people discovered several instruments, which were greatly useful in the daily life. But they had never thought of merchandising their products.

The people of later years developed the same products further and merchandised them. The people brought all their products to the common marketplaces which were far away from their settlements. They exchanged food products, farm tools, cloths, precious stones, new varieties of weapons, swift legged horses, goats, cows and still several other things with each other. Much later gold, silver and copper coins were introduced to buy and sell the products.

People living in the forests supplied forest products like timber, honey, fruits, pepper, cardamom and still several other spices. The people of seashores built and sold small fishing boats. They made fishing nets and marketed them. They also fished out pearls and other precious stones from the seabed. They brought them to the common marketplaces to sell them

there. Out of the sea water they prepared salt and that was their main merchandise. The people settled on the riverbanks supplied grains, goats, and other cattle, whereas those in the rocky deserts brought horses, camels, rocky salts and precious metals and stones to the market.

All the groups mingled with each other at the marketplaces. They all wished to travel further to explore the possibilities of earning still more. They travelled on donkeys, horses, and camels with their products. Later they designed carts which were pulled by the above said animals to carry more loads of merchandise.

Some of the groups later developed huge yachts and sailed over ocean with their different varieties of merchandise to the unknown shores. In their search for other countries, they found the shores of other continents. They expanded their settlements and migrated to the other continents too. There they enslaved the vulnerable natives. Later the slaves also became their merchandise.

Some ambitious groups of mankind had the passionate wish to travel vastly and explore the

possibilities of amassing great fortunes. The desire to earn more wealth grew in their hearts. The kings also desired to expand their territory. On those days it was the prime duty of the kings, expanding their territory and kept the new territory under their control. Fighting wars, killing people, and forcibly occupying others' places were the prime duties of the kings. They developed skilled armies with better weapons. They invaded and occupied richer settlements. There were frequent wars among the groups to occupy richer places. The wars turned out to be so cruel and caused great loss of people and their property.

The killings of their beloved fellow beings and the sufferings of common people in the wars awakened the ancient wise people's conscious. Why could people not live in harmony with others? This question haunted them, and they found out that greed was the prime factor for the violent conflicts. The greed caused all human problems, they discovered. They found that greed had the destructive power. The greed didn't allow people to behave with the minimum, basic

love, and concern for the fellow beings. They also realized that the greed was totally self-centred.

The wise people felt that, to have the peace and love, the people should eliminate greed, which was the root cause for all the violence and pains. After deep contemplation the wise people formatted basic code of conducts to eliminate violence and bring forth love and peace among the people. They believed that the basic code of conducts could help people to shun away the greed. They preached people to live according to the basic code of conducts. They declared that the violators of the basic code of conducts were the violators of Nature's law, and the violators could not escape from the wrath of God, they cautioned.

The wise people tried to cultivate love, care, and concern for fellow beings in human hearts. To start with, they requested people to look after their aged parents with love, care, and concern. They asked people to shoulder the responsibility of their family. They advised to maintain healthy environment and keep one's physical body and clothes clean. They taught people to value and revere the nature, which had been providing all

the needs of life. They recommended virtuous life that should be useful to others. They advised people not to have jealous on others. The people should not be greedy and should have contented hearts. The people should lead simple life and should not be extravagant.

The wise men preached people to love all and hate none. Showing authority was evil and equality should be the law of the land, they recommended. They advised not to cast evil eyes on others property and women. Both men and women should be loyal to their life partners. The people should not steal and not to get angry also. The people should not be selfish.

The wise people preached to the masses to help and serve each other at the time of need. They instructed people not to lie. The people should eschew violence and should not injure others both psychologically and physically, they advised. The people should always keep their words and uphold the truth. The people should be honest. The friendship and relationship should be trustworthy.

The wise people announced that forgetting the faults of others was a good human act and forgiving the offender was a great divine act. Feeding the starving poor and giving them proper education were considered great virtues. At the same time the wise people advised not to beg anything from anybody. One should work hard for one's bread and other essentials of life. To some groups, which had higher number of females than males, the wise people approved men marrying more than one girl. In other places, where the ratio between males and females were equal, the wise suggested one girl for one man.

The wise people preached such dos and don'ts in the name of God. The preaching of wise people is amazingly same around the world. The dos were called "virtues" of life and the don'ts "sins". The present-day laws of almost all countries are based upon these teachings of wise people. Their preaching was effective. Most of the people were able to understand the value of teachings and adopt them in their daily life.



The people could at last find meaning and value of their life. The basic code of conducts had succeeded in bringing the dignity to the human life and helped people to move towards God. The love and concern for the fellow beings becomes the reality in the human life only because of the compassionate works of great wise people of all times.

Despite the repeated teachings of wise people, there had been still a few passionate, ambitious, violent, and arrogant groups of people, who wanted to fight and kill. They craved for power and authority. They imagined that fighting wars was heroic act. They wanted to expand their territory and establish their authority there.

The products that were created by wise people for the betterment of human life were further developed and misused in wars. Steadily the violent groups conquered others territory and integrated them with their territories to form their countries. They designed flags to gain identification for their countries. They hoisted their flags on their borders and forts. Gradually the flags gained importance and the people were

taught to respect their country's flag. The flags were the symbols of their countries. Every country had uniquely designed colourful flag and there were lot of thesis behind the colours and designs of the flags.

Thus, various countries were carved on Earth by the violent and greedy nature of mankind. Several wars were fought to occupy richer countries. The winners looted the losers' countries and kept those countries under their control.

Even today some countries are secretly upholding this attitude and working for it. There are growing border disputes among some of the adjacent countries even in this scientifically advanced modern time and these disputes are ready to burst into wars at any point of time. The war clouds, it seems, for one reason or other, are always hovering over mankind and it is the most worrisome factor for the sensible people around the world.

Even though the teachings of wise people preached love, peace, service, sacrifice and

universal brotherhood, those violent groups didn't eschew violence from their hearts. They continued to run after their greed for power, possession, and authority. For them the teachings were just meant to be worshipped, but not to be implemented in the daily life.

They sought Gods of their religions to bestow success on their violent endeavours. They invaded other countries and enslaved their opponents. They insulted the principles and sentiments of other religions. There were violent retaliations. The people fought and killed each other in the names of Gods and Countries. This fighting nature of human was labelled as patriotism and heroism. The dead warriors were called 'martyr' and the killers were addressed as 'hero'.

Almost all the enslaved countries were liberated later by the great works and sacrifices of wise people. The wise people always valued freedom. They breathed freedom, they preached freedom and they lived in freedom. They never offended or intervened in other's freedom.

The religious fanatics around the world never allowed such divine people to work freely for the betterment of people. They tried to snatch the freedom of wise people by imposing severe restrictions. The wise people, who never cared about their own welfare, didn't bother about the restrictions. They stood firmly and majestically in their stands. They had been continuously preaching the value of freedom, love, and God to the masses. Those great selfless wise people had to face cruel sufferings and merciless killings by the arrogant and authoritarian rulers and religionists.

All the old and new religions had divided people into multiple sections. The intellectual religionists divided the mankind cunningly to establish their supremacy over the society. the hunger and illiteracy in the countries from where the money has come. There could be basic infrastructure for every human if the money is properly utilized. But the insensitive, irresponsible, and selfish rulers of these countries do not realize their crime against the whole human race.

Let us hope that they will repent of their crime soon, reveal the identity of the culprits and release the latter's idle, ill-gotten money for the welfare of the mankind. Even though the culprits are trying to block the initiatives of revealing their names and confiscating their ill-gotten money, this will be done in due course for the welfare of the whole humanity by the grace of wise people.

The rich Multinational companies are doing great business by exploiting the ecology of Earth as well as the poor ignorant people. The Multinational Companies have occupied thousands of acres of cultivable and forest lands for their industrial use around the world. Somewhere in the world, the governments forcibly snatch the cultivable rich lands from the

poor peasants at a very low cost and give the same to the rich Multinational companies. These rich companies' industrial units are installed there.

These industries pollute the atmosphere and cause untold sufferings to the poor people. They consume more water and consequently there is water scarcity for both drinking and irrigation in the nearby villages. They also discharge the untreated, contaminated water into the nearby rivers and sea. Thus, the industries are polluting the whole atmosphere and causing health hazard to the people living near these industries.

The fertile rich lands, which were once the pride of the peasants, have been spoiled. The greenery has been reduced. The fertile lands have become dry waste lands. The industrial growth is nowadays at the cost of the agriculture profession and the poor people's life. The industrial pollution ruins the atmosphere and damages the ecology. It affects everyone on Earth. If the administration of the industries does not maintain clean and hygiene environment, it shall be dealt by the Nature soon and it is certain

that no one can withstand the fury of the Nature's mighty retaliation.

The Multinational Companies that have occupied the prime agriculture land for their industrial purpose should be instructed to develop equal areas of dry wastelands into cultivable lands by investing small portion of their income. These Companies should be brought into the social sphere, and they should realize their social responsibility and accountability. Nowadays they remain aloof, mechanical, ruthless, and money-making machines. They are also one of the prime reasons for the present-day turmoil of the world. If they would undertake the above-mentioned noble job, there would be a lot of job opportunities for the poor masses. The problem of global warming, ecological imbalance, the shortage of food products and starvation among the poor masses could be reduced to great extent. The unhealthy migration from the villages to the urban areas could also be averted.

The governments of all countries should effectively order the Multinational Companies to undertake this great noble service by allotting to

them the undeveloped dry lands at market price. The companies should be instructed to do only agriculture on these lands in scientific way and provide basic infrastructures for the people who would work there. In that way the affluent sects of society could also join in the work to improve the living conditions of the poor, starving, impoverished and downtrodden people of the world.

Nowadays the farmers could not earn enough money despite their hard work in their fields and so they wish to switch over to other jobs. The agriculture profession has lost its charm. The farmers are not able to get sufficient price for their produce every time. Sometimes they must sell their produce at throwaway prices.

Moreover, the people of other sectors in almost every country do not give due regards and respect to the farmers. The people degrade the noble agricultural profession. The Governments of almost all countries spare great time to encourage the industrial growth and have no time and interest to develop and support the agriculture. The noble agriculture job of

producing food grains, pulses, vegetables, and fruits is not given due respect and importance. It is considered low grade job in the society.

Nowadays even the children of the farmers do not want to do farm activities, considering it as an undignified profession. The Governments also do not value and encourage the farmers either. The affluent educated people and the governments do not give enough attention to the problems of the farmers.

In most of the countries there is no sufficient water either to irrigate the fields. The perennial rivers of the past time have become dry now. They are flooded during the monsoon, destroy the properties because of its rich sands have been looted by the greedy powerful people of the society for the use of construction industry. The precious river water wastefully flows into the ocean directly. The underground water level has gone miles deep, and the open wells have become dry. In some countries people walk miles to get a pot of drinking water.

There is no electricity in the villages of developing and poor countries. There are no fully equipped hospitals, no good affordable schools and colleges, no roads even and not to talk about the sanitary conditions of the villages, where the farmers live.

The farmers are not able to live their life with the meagre income they get for their hard work. Peasants in every country are more or less uneducated. The Governments have not taken any steps to educate the farmers and dignify their profession. They do not equip farmers with modern scientific techniques and instruments in the developing and poor countries. The availability of agriculture labourers has also become scarce nowadays. The industries, construction companies and other business establishments in the cities have attracted people with good salary and so the agriculture labourers switch over to them.

Generally, the people feel security by getting assured salary, whereas there is always uncertainty in the agriculture profession. If the monsoon fails, they suffer. If there is excess rain,

then also they suffer. Sometimes the insects destroy their produce and make havoc in the lives of farmers. Consequently, they land in debt trap, which would make their life torturous. The untold sufferings of farmers finally end in suicide in most of the poor and developing countries. The Governments of these countries do not take effective steps to support and protect the farmers.

Nowadays every farmer wants his children to get good education. They wish their children to switch over to some other white-collar jobs. The farmers do not want their children to suffer like they suffer in the villages. They sell their lands to educate their children. Nowadays the cost of land is very high. So, the peasants are selling their agriculture land for industrial or residential purposes, which would yield huge amount that could not be earned even by toiling in the fields for decades.

In most of the developing countries, the Governments forcibly snatch the cultivable fertile lands from the farmers and convert them into industrial zones. The governments are giving

more importance to the industrial growth than the development of agriculture. Nowhere in the world one can hear that the excess of industrial land has been snatched by the governments from the multinational companies and distributed the same among the poor peasants to do agriculture.

The cultivable lands have been reduced to great extent. Consequently, there is less production of food grains, pulses, vegetables, and fruits. Their prices are soaring up nowadays. The farmers are also dejected and have lost interest in their profession. They migrate to urban areas after selling their farmlands. They try to set up some small business or do some petty jobs in the cities. They enrol their children in the schools there and dream that one day their children would become highly qualified and rich in the society. The cities all over the world are congested due to the migration of poor peasants. They live in slums, which are rapidly growing in the cities.

Plenty of small and big industries are developed in and around urban areas and they offer employment to both the skilled and unskilled workers in large numbers. Such the cities are

flooded with more human habitation that has resulted in congestion and pollution.

The greenery of the cities is gradually disappearing due to the over population and industrialization. The whole ecological system has been imbalanced in almost all the nations, and it has become the huge problem for everyone. The resultant global warming has caused erratic monsoons. Frequent floods, droughts, earthquakes, and still more natural disasters occur unexpectedly and affect all the living creatures.

Due to the greedy and irresponsible attitude of a few ruling class people and the ruthless industrialists, Mother Earth is struggling, and its greenery is dying slowly. The rivers are drying up. The common birds and animals have become extinct. Varieties of new diseases attack animals and human beings. If the trend continues, the life span of everything in this world will be reduced.

If the people and their governments are not awakened, the survival of the beautiful creatures of Mother Earth including the Human Beings will

become difficult soon. Pure potable water and pollution free air have become scarce. Nowadays people are buying water to drink and somewhere in the world, people must pay to inhale oxygen.

The wise people around the world are tirelessly voicing for the importance of pollution free atmosphere and greenery. They try to educate people to protect our forests, rivers, and other natural wealth. They teach people that only the pollution free Earth could provide better living conditions and safety to all creatures including human being. Let us hope that the mankind will listen to the concerned voice of wise people and correct their mistakes by safeguarding the forests and rivers.

Education is the one more field, which have been neglected by all the countries and allowed the same to fall into the wrong, greedy, and tainted hands. The Governments, which should give top priority to regulate this field, ignore it by giving the least attention to it.

The Governments of all countries should see their citizens properly educated. The education

should be either at affordable cost or totally free. The education strengthens people's knowledge and kindles their intelligence. Every individual in this world should have the opportunity to get proper education. In most of the countries, education becomes the lucrative business. The poor masses are deprived their rights of having good education. Nowadays the rich people alone can afford to get standard education for their children.

The educational institutions, which are meant to teach the danger of greed and selfishness, are functioning these days with passionate greed to earn money, money alone. Even the religious people and their organizations are running their educational institutions with the motive of earning more money to stabilize their religions and to fatten their own wallets. They are selling the knowledge of arts and science to richer students and denying education to the poor masses. This deplorable situation prevails everywhere in the world. Somewhere in the world, the Governments undertake the responsibility of selling the liquors, but least

bothering to undertake the responsibility of educating their citizens.

Most of the political heads of the poor countries deliberately want to keep their citizens uneducated and ignorant for their own craze for power and money. In these countries there are schools, but no sufficient teachers. Even if there were teachers, the governments of these countries do not pay salary to the teachers regularly.

With starving stomach, the children also do not have the interest to get education in schools. The politicians taking advantage of the ignorance of poor masses give some attractive freebies to show themselves as the saviours of people and win the elections. Whereas the real saviours, the great wise people remain incognito, the duplicates are basking in the publicity.

The refusal of sharing food, knowledge and wealth with the needy people has resulted in unbearable terrorism in almost all the countries. Even then, the affluent politicians, the top bureaucrats of the Governments and the big

business companies of all countries do not realize their responsibilities to feed and educate the needy poor people. They do not provide the poor masses with the basic needs of human life. The health of the poor masses is dangerously ignored. They allow the poor people to die in pain due to the lack of key facilities in the Government hospitals. Only the rich people can afford to get treatment in the expensive corporate hospitals. The poor suffer and die.

The humanity of mankind gradually disappears despite scores of religions and their teachings and the rapid growth of science and technology. The people get tired of the present-day rich community and Governments. The impatience and unrest of the masses is rapidly growing and waiting to explode. The only way to escape from this horrible situation is everyone should apply the basic code of conducts in the daily life that have been codified by the wise people.

The burning greed of human race has melted millions of years old ancient glaciers of the world and consequently the sea level has increased. The rise of sea level endangers several low-lying

countries. The global warming is certainly due to the greed of human beings. It is the reason for the erratic climatic conditions and monsoons, which is damaging the life sustenance in the whole world. The global warming that has been caused by the irresponsible human behaviours could be cooled down only when the masses begin to practice the basic code of conducts, formatted by the wise people. Then alone this beautiful earth could be saved and shall become the paradise thereafter for every creature.



## **5. Castes and Conditions of Women**

The ancient religious leaders considered themselves as the messiahs of God. They claimed that they had directly descended from God, and they alone had the rights to legislate laws and disciplines for the common people. They felt the need of multiple sections to perform various functions of the society. They, in consultation with the kings, divided people into multiple sections. They named every section. The sections were legally approved. The kings and the religious leaders codified laws for every section in the name of God. They dictated people to obey the laws.

The kings and the religious leaders allotted different works to the different sections of people in the society. They retained the power with themselves to legislate and amend the laws for the society. They passed on the rights to legislate laws in future to their successors.

The Kings reserved the rights of ruling, protecting, managing, and leading the society.

The Gods, religions, and the rights to create rituals were in the possession of the religious leaders. The job of fighting enemy and policing the people to maintain law and order were allocated to the strongest and aggressive people of the society. They were directly under the control of the King. The job of storing and distribution of food grains and other essential materials was given to the friends of the lawmakers. All other people were taught to be the servants of the above-mentioned groups. Those least valued humans should perform all other mean jobs like cleaning, washing, working in the farms, breeding the cattle, and completing the miscellaneous needs of all other groups.

The formatters thus divided people into several such groups, which were later called “castes” in some countries. All the castes were named, and the people were instructed to mention their caste with their names. Lot of subdivisions were also branched out according to the fanciful whim of the powerful formatters. People’s physical features, their capability, their intelligence, their skill, and their skin colours too had contributed

to segregate people from one another. These all have happened gradually in the course of time.

All these sections were created in the names of Gods and religions. The authoritative groups formatted harsh oppressive rules and regulations for the subservient people.

The wise people of those times invented money to purchase products for the convenience of people. But the opportunistic religious people arranged the society in strange ways that except the subservient group, all other sections could earn money and become rich, whereas the unfortunate poor subservient creatures were denied opportunities to earn money. They were also denied the basic needs and comforts.

Education, knowledge, social dignity, and religious rituals were beyond their reach. Even God was beyond their reach! They should not do any rituals connected with the religions and Gods. They should not enter the religious worshipping places. They were restricted even in using the roads. They were also instructed and

taught how they should bow, walk, dress, and behave before the other superior class people.

They should not demand money for the works they did for the higher-class people. They should accept with all humbleness, whatever the upper-class people would throw at them. They should not have their settlements near the upper-class people's residential places. They should not draw water from the wells, which were allocated for the upper-class people. They should not make use of the ponds the upper-class people used. They should have separate place in the downstream of the river and were denied permission to use the convenient bathing places in the upstream that were used by the upper-class people.

If anybody opposed, disobeyed, or even murmured against the rules and regulations, they would be tortured, expelled from the society, and isolated. If those people did not repent, they would even be killed by the upper-class people.

In almost all the civilizations, the caste systems were formatted and imposed in different forms

and names. There might be some variations in the styles of formatting different groups, but basically the religious leaders all over the world divided people into different sections or castes. Every section of the people should live as a community in separate places where they had been dictated to live. They should have the matrimonial relationships only among their own community. If anybody violated the caste based matrimonial rule, they would be tortured, sometimes even be killed as per the command of the community head. They called these killings “Honour Killing”.

In every community, the womenfolk had no freedom at all. The girl children were prohibited to get education. Women should always be subservient to their male partners. They were used for all the needs of males whereas their own needs were left unaddressed. Their emotions, likes and dislikes were not cared.

Understanding the value of women’s role in the great play of human existence, the wise people of all times concentrated on the welfare of womenfolk and showered their love, compassion,

concern, and care on them. They understood the pains and problems of women and strengthened the womenfolk with their spiritual energy. They advised men to treat women with respect, love, and care. The wise people's top priority was to safeguard women from the persecution of men throughout the world.

In all castes, classes, communities, religions and nations, women were the worst sufferers in every adverse effect that fell upon the human beings. To protect the womenfolk from the social problems and other general abuses, the wise people projected them as the forms of Supreme Goddesses, so that men would respect them, glorify them, and treat them properly. It is only of late one can hear a few intellectual people claiming that women are equal to men. But the wise people have declared long ago that women are the source of creation and energy and so they are remarkable and beyond comparison.

The living condition of most of the women in this world has ever been pathetic and painful. On seeing the horrible living conditions of women, the wise people had stepped in to protect them.

They codified virtues for women. Even though the laws are directed towards women, the codification controls indirectly the males too. The rules not only protect the womenfolk, but also the whole society.

The wise people knew that the welfare of women was vital for the welfare of the whole human beings. The codified laws that were amended by the wise people for the women bind all castes, classes, and communities. The codified laws for women had become the seeds of new cultures and civilizations that had created new era in the world.

The women became free to certain extent due to the consistent efforts of wise people. They were able to learn about God and Life. They were allowed to gain knowledge and work to improve the general social life. They were permitted to exercise their rights to choose their life partners. They were able to be supportive to their life partners. Their suggestions during the crucial circumstances were solicited, valued, and accepted. They also participated in the works of

men to improve the general condition of human life.

Due to the great efforts of wise people, a few women from different society had attained wisdom of God and Life. The wise women had to break the conventional barriers of the society in the names of religions and cults.

Once they reached the state of perfection, they started serving the society. They taught people, particularly women, patience, love, sacrifice, and devotion on God. They advised womenfolk to love and take care of their own families. They preached that the women should take the responsibility of their family members' physical, mental, and spiritual health. The wise women also clarified that if every woman took care of their own family, the whole world would become the paradise.

The wise people taught that the lust for opposite sex prevents one reaching God. Some religious people had misinterpreted the wise people's words. They propagated that love and care for womenfolk was the prime reason for men's fall.

In fact, the wise people condemned the lust of both men and women. They suggested people that one could love and live with wife or husband and have children. That's the moral arrangement. One should abide by it, but, luring the opposite gender other than the matrimonial relationship is not acceptable. It is lust. It is sin. It is lust that causes the fall of both genders and not love, the wise people said.

Love is the binding factor of both men and women. Love generates care, concern, sacrifice, service, intelligence, and wisdom. Love is the nature of human, whereas lust is the product of thought. Love stands majestically as moral, and the lust remains immoral that causes fear, conflicts, and pain.

It is natural to have sexual instincts. Hence the wise people formatted marriage system, a decent and dignified way to quench the sexual instincts of both male and female. Such relationships could develop love and responsibility among the couples and dignify the social life.

The wise people had felt that sexual instincts should be given subtle attention, because it is vital for the existence of human race. So, they formatted marriage system with spiritual fervour. The marriage system was formatted to eradicate lust from human hearts and bind both the male and female in love. That is the virtue of social life, the wise people preached.

Most of the wise people of all times are married and have children. They know the art of love and they are the living examples showing the world that love is not a sin. There are some exemptions too. Even though, those exempted wise people are not married, they know the contents of human life.

Generally, the wise people renounce everything due to the clarion call of God. They renounce their name, fame, power, money, family and finally their own 'self' that contain sexual instincts and other desires. They are totally one with God. They prefer to be alone. They see God alone in everything and in everybody. They dedicate their entire life for God and God's creations. They transcend their body conscious.

They live in solitude and whenever the world requires their services, they shall come out of their solitude to serve people. After they complete their works, they would just go away by dropping their physical frames. This way of life is holy, and it is adored and worshipped by people.

There were lot of divine couples in the ancient time, both husband and wife realized their oneness with God and totally dedicated their lives to the service of God. Even though they lived together, they were free of sexual instincts as they had transcended their body conscious and become totally one with God.

The wife served her husband and enabled him to transcend his 'self' and realize his oneness with God. By serving her husband selflessly, the wife became totally one with her husband, who was none but God for her. Some of those great divine couples rarely bestowed children. Sometimes some of those children guided and helped the mankind to move towards God.

The cunning religious bigheads had jealousy on seeing the people's reverence and adoration for

wise people. They thought of themselves as great devotees of God and had the eligibility to receive the reverence from people, even though they were undeserved for such respects and regards. They wanted people to bow before them and worship them.

One could see such religious leaders even now. They decorate themselves with odd religious garbs and have strange and peculiar names and styles. They do not aware that they are trying to duplicate the wise people by repeating the same words of the latter. Such duplicates do not have the strength and courage to get rid of their silly desires and lust. These duplicates cause havoc in the society.

The holy works done by the wise people were again disturbed by the religious fanatics. Particularly their works towards the freedom of women irritated the religious leaders and so they wanted to curtail the movement. The religious bigheads amended new bylaws against women. They dictated dress code for the womenfolk. The dresses should cover the entire body of women from head to feet.

The religionists denied education to the womenfolk. Women were deprived of the basic rights and say in the common interests of the society and country. They were even refused entry into the religious worshipping places in certain countries. The religionists amended rules only to make the women subservient to the males and confining themselves within the four walls of their houses. The only work for the women was to serve their male partners doing household works and rear their children.

In such conditions the girl children were neglected, and the male children were looked after well. The good food and other comforts were given only to the male children. The girl children should work hard since from their childhood. Once the girl children attained puberty, the laws applied to the grown-up women would be enforced on them.

The boys could go to the school and get education. They would have ample time to play with their friends and enjoy their childhood, but the girls should not go to the school. The

religionists insisted that the women should remain illiterate. They did this deliberately so that the womenfolk would ever be ignorant. The women should always depend on men in every stage of their life. This practice continues in some part of the world. These atrocities on women should be condemned and the men behind these crimes should feel ashamed.

The religionists insisted that the girl children should get married at very young age. The parents of girl children should offer considerable wealth, gold jewellery and other essentials of home to the bridegroom during wedding. This kind of child marriages made the girl children subservient to the other members of their in-laws' family. Sometimes they were exploited by the elderly males of the family, and it was an awkward situation for the girl children. They had to keep mum and curse themselves for being females.

The girl children in due course learned the way of life soon and worked tirelessly for the welfare of all other family members till the very end of their life. In those times, the life span of girls was very

short, and their lives were full of sorrows and pains. Even at the age of 12 they would become mothers. Every childbirth of those times was torturous and most of the times fatal.

Due to the degrading and disgusted situations of the girls and women in the society, the common folks disliked girl children. When some of the parents knew that it was a girl baby born to them, they mercilessly organized to kill the new-born baby girl by poisoning. This habit of murdering new-born girl children continues even now in some parts of the world. Thousands of girl children were killed in such way as the parents saw bleak future for them. The worried parents thought that it would be better to kill the girl babies than seeing them suffering lifelong.

Earlier the population ratio of males and females was almost equal. During those times, the wise people enforced the rule of one wife, one husband. The frequent conflicts and wars between the various groups alarmingly reduced the male population. The reduction of the male population caused havoc in the society. It

triggered social disorder. So, the wise people of those times stepped in to correct the disorder.

They suggested and encouraged men marrying several girls. The multiple wife system helped to improve the population ratio. The balancing of the population ratio was their prime task then. The wise people also valued and understood the human sexual instincts. They gave dignified cultural decorum to the human instincts by suggesting men marrying several girls. Again, gradually the population ratio between men and women improved and it's all due to the wisdom of wise people.

Thereafter due to the inhuman, oppressive bylaws of the religionists, the men did not care much about women. They used women only for their comforts and pleasures. They didn't bother about women's discomforts and pains both physical and psychological. The degrading and disgusted conditions of girls and women in the society had reduced the lifespan of women. This along with the female infanticide reduced the ratio of females and in due course men had to

fight to win the girls to have the matrimonial relationship.

However due to the serious preaching and efforts of wise people the ill-treating of girl children has been reduced to certain extent. The female infanticide has also been reduced. Such the female ratio has improved again and become almost equal to their male counterparts. Nowadays one husband, one wife is the rule of the land in most of the countries. The dignity of social life has been re-established by the tireless works of wise people. Though the population ratio is almost balanced all over the world, still some religions and their leaders advocate multi marriage system just to quench men's lust as well as to swell their population in this religiously divided world.

Apart from the codified laws by the wise people, the religious leaders from time to time forcibly enforced one after another bylaw exclusively for the women in some countries.

The women, who became widows, were considered great burden to the family as well as

to the society. So, they were burnt alive at some places on the pyre of their dead husbands. It was considered as holy, religious, and divine act. Rarely a few women would volunteer to be burnt alive along with their dead husbands either out of fear of their survival or out of their deep love on their husbands.

The ritualistic religionists had built monuments in remembrance of those poor widows, who were burnt on the pyre of their dead husbands. They created rituals to worship the burnt widows. The religionists killed the widows to worship them! It was God's grace that a few wise people came later and wiped away this religiously organized crime from the face of Earth.

The widows, who were allowed to live after the death of their husbands, had to adopt harsh disciplines in the daily life. Even a simple and healthy food was denied to the widows. The society degraded them. They were deprived of their basic rights to live with dignity.

In some part of the world, they should tonsure and cover their body with coarse clothes. They

were considered the sign of bad luck and were forbidden to come on the way of people. They were also forbidden to see religious leaders face to face in some communities.

The wise people worked against such laws and showered their abundant grace on those poor widows. They encouraged the widows to have the normal life without outside symbols of widowhood. They allowed the widows to undertake the responsibilities of their children for the latter's healthy and virtuous growth. They guided the poor widows to remember God constantly and get courage and strength. The present day dignified life of widows is because of the compassionate hard works of wise people.

Somewhere in Asia, the religious people developed one newer sect exclusively for the service of Gods and religions. The young ladies of that community should inculcate devotion on God in the hearts of common people by singing and dancing before the deities of the worshipping places. In every festival and on auspicious days they would perform their programs in the worshipping places.

The art of classical singing and classical dance were developed by that community in great enthusiastic ways. The wise people's compositions were tuned, sung, and danced by the beautiful ladies of that community. People used to get trance on seeing their performances. Without their dedicated and sincere service, the devotional songs of wise people and the enchanting tunes would have been vanished for ever from the society.

The affluent religious and authoritarian men of the society did not leave those women of that community either to lead dignified life. They corrupted them by presenting precious jewellery and high valued properties. The ritualistic religionists codified special laws for them. They declared that the women of the said sect should serve Gods by making the rich religionists and other authoritarian people of the society happy by sharing their beds with the latter. If those women refused, they had to face the wrath of the Kings and religious leaders.

The religious people emphasized that it was the duty of the girls from that sect to serve God by the way of quenching men's lust. The women of that sect should not get married. They should not think about family setup. They should not have the free will because they were the slaves of God. They should learn classical songs and dance. They should lead their life out of the merciful offerings of the visitors. This practice was the beginning of the prostitution in some countries.

Systematically the religious people subjugated the womenfolk and carried out atrocities against them psychologically, physiologically, and spiritually. Subsequently most of the women of all castes and communities became vulnerable and silently tolerated all the atrocities with great patience.

Right from their birth till their death, the suffering they encountered was terrible. Those sufferings prompted the wise people to come among the society again and again from their solitude. They worked to remove the sufferings of women and taught people about the value of

both genders and importance of love and concern for the fellow beings.

The wise men in almost every country worked so intensely to break the slavery of women. The past pathetic conditions of women of all communities get sweeping changes nowadays, only because of the tireless works of great wise people of this world.

The general conditions of women of all communities in all countries have improved well only due to the grace of wise people. Nowadays most of the womenfolk can study and acquire knowledge. They are consulted by their male partners in important events and their decisions are valued and appreciated. They can express their feelings and interests in fairly intelligent ways. They can decide about their marriages too.

They have the rights in most of the countries to cast their votes, contest the elections and participate in the function of governments. Somewhere they even capture the highest position of the country.

The women classical singers and dancers nowadays have become part of the culture. They are valued, honoured, and referred as artists. Now they could marry and lead normal life like any other women.

In spite of the above-mentioned improvements, the atrocities against women have not been completely erased. When comparing with the past, it is reduced to some extent. The people have awareness nowadays that women are the nucleus of cultures and civilizations.

Places where women can freely walk, freely think, and express, where they can easily get proper education and where their emotions are valued, have become prosperous, blessed, and privileged. Such places should prevail everywhere on the Earth. The consistent works of wise people will see to it that it will happen in all countries soon.

It is exciting to see women talking nowadays about the spiritual and other common social matters with brilliance of intelligence and seriousness. The wise people of all times

throughout the world are working hard even today to bring this great transformation, but alas such wise people go unrecognized. It seems they choose to remain incognito. They are doing great revolutionary works silently, even today, with the same seriousness and compassion without expecting anything in return from the society.

Despite this great evolution, it is painful to see that there are some women misusing their freedom for their momentary pleasures and transient elation. Their rude behaviours, ill characters, idiotic selfish attitudes, and high egoism have tainted the pure womanhood. Most of such women, due to their rude behaviours, suffer with immense pain. They face huge problems in their life. They would search for solace and peace in the worshipping places and finally some of them reach the holy feet of wise people. They would get the transformation by the magic touch of the great wise people and at last they would join the mainstream of the pure and great womanhood.

Similarly, there are some arrogant men, who behave violently against women in the same old

rotten ways. They also dominate other vulnerable fellow human beings. Such people still try to uphold their superiority over others in the name of religions, castes, and gender. Their activities damage the social system and give extreme sufferings to everybody directly or indirectly. They are not even aware of it, and they still pursue their senseless paths. They too should get the transformation, which is possible only through the compassionate grace and attention of wise people.

The wise people shall come again and again into this world to transform these arrogant women and men of the society by pushing them onwards in the right path. They would work on these men and women and enable them to attain wisdom of life, discriminating capability and love, so that they cannot harm others. We should salute these saviours of mankind with the sense of gratitude and devotion with all our hearts, for their fabulous works to make this world a worthy living paradise.

Nowadays, it is the common sight that most of the urban people are not bothering about their

fellow beings. They do not have the time to think about others. In this competitive world, their own survival and comforts are the main issues for them. Astonishingly they are selfish, and they are not able to feel the pains and emotions of others.

The human touch between man to man becomes less and sometimes not possible at all. The wise people are trying to revive love and care for fellow beings in these heartless men and women in the urban areas by teaching them the spiritual wisdom, which is realizing oneness with all.

Generally, people would consider their associations with others in terms of presentable look, financial status, social positions, academic qualifications and religious beliefs. They may converse with apparent seriousness about equality, but during the complicated situation in their own personal lives, the deciding factor would be selfishness, caste, community, financial status, and religions.

There are disorders in the social life. Pains and problems are mounting day by day in every

country around the world. Every individual is affected by these disorders and pain. The only medicine for these disorders is the wisdom prescribed by wise people which have the magical power to cure all of them. The brave accepts, consumes the medicine of wisdom, and is cured. They would become normal. They start loving, caring, and having concern for fellow beings. They love everything and learn from everything. They alone could have the deep contemplation on God and lead simple, honest, and useful life.

The cowards would run away from the wise people and their teachings. They hide themselves behind some religions and its beliefs to stabilize their lives, but alas, the same religions and its beliefs destabilize them and shake their very existence.

The apparent believers of religions and Gods appear to be great devotees with immense humility, whereas most of them are selfish, arrogant, and violent. They are almost insane. They are cruel. They hurt others to protect their communities and religions. And most of the time

they get vehement retaliation for their misdeeds and thus their lives are destabilized. They face the persecution and pains. Every aching soul shall finally reach the feet of wise people, who will alleviate their sufferings by imparting the divine wisdom to them.

Due to the consistent works of wise people, nowadays the imbalance between the different castes, classes and communities of the society has been reduced to a great extent. Still there are some disorders here and there that can be seen in the society.

The present-day religious leaders, who have great establishments, are not serious to correct these disorders. It seems they too contribute for the development of the imbalance in the society either knowingly or unknowingly. Though they preach that God is unbiased and equally present in all beings, they are unable to tolerate the equality among the human beings. They preach in one way and live in another way. However, the mankind evolves gradually into a highly advanced society of total equality by the

compassionate grace of the incognito wise people.

The passionate supporters of castes, classes and religions are highly disturbed on seeing the present-day development of the people's consistent advancement towards the formation of casteless, classless and spiritual society. They keep dreaming of their past period of domination.

The wise people alone could transform these disturbed people and house them in the reality of Life and God. This is one of the prime missions of the wise people. Let us have the faith that humans of this beautiful world shall have the unbiased equality, literacy, prosperity, harmony and wisdom of Life and God in the near future by the grace of the great incognito wise people.

## **6. The Worshipping Places**

The ancient wise people had never suggested the idea of worshipping places to the mankind in any part of the world. They had the direct perception of God in everything. They saw God alone everywhere. They didn't feel the necessity of having an exclusive worshipping place to remember and glorify God.

They had the conviction that whatever happened, happened by the will of God. Wherever they went they saw God alone. Their oneness with God was total. The divine forms of such great wise people were deserved to be worshiped. The common people adored them and listened to them. They tried to live a perfect human life by following the wise people.

Those divine wise people preferred to live alone, away from the human habitation. Whenever they sensed that something should be done to the society then alone they would come among the people from their solitude. They would come

down from their supreme state of oneness with God and mingle with the common people.

They asked people to remember God with simple but determined heart. They guided people to become one with God. They taught the plain truth that remembering God is the only solution for all human problems. When one remembers God, naturally one would begin to love all. Where there is love, there could be only peace, wisdom, joy and harmony. One should work to attain this supreme state of love and this alone should be the purpose of life. Begging something from God without working and deserving for it is a futile exercise, the ancient wise people had declared.

The ancient wise people had never said that God manifests only in specific places. They never had suggested any form of rituals either to worship God. They realized and announced that human hearts alone could be the real worshipping places. They wished every individual should make his or her heart a worshipping place.

The wise people insisted to keep one's worshipping place, "heart", clean and it should be

one's top priority. The pure hearts are those which are free from lust and greed. Such hearts are the real, divine worshipping places, they declared. Love, sacrifice, faith and wisdom would well up naturally from such hearts and they are the real dwelling places of God.

Nowadays there are varieties of religious worshipping places, which have been sprouted in almost every corner of the streets. Only a few ancient worshipping places, which have the direct links of wise people, are significant. The people flood these places. The people frequent these worshipping places to seek divine grace to fulfil their desires and drive away the ill effects of life.

Some of them get some beneficial things in their life and they go on talking about them to exhibit their devotion on the Gods of these worshipping places. They claim that due to their sincere prayers in these worshipping places, they are able to attain the desired benefits in their life. Such propaganda attracts more crowds and the particular worshipping place becomes very popular.

The other religious people become jealousy on seeing the popularity of their opponents' Gods and their worshipping places. To compete with the other religions, they organize to build new worshipping places and try to popularize their own religions and Gods. They assemble people at their worshipping places on a particular day of every week or month or somewhere daily. They take serious efforts to brainwash and convert the common people to their beliefs with loud promises and rewards.

These religious people assume that converting people to their religion is one of the noble jobs and it's the great service to God. Some people take up this conversion job because of the promises of wealth and heaven from the religious leaders. Lot of money, comforts and titles are involved in the religious conversion works and that's why the passionate religious people tirelessly work spending their energy and valuable time for this so-called holy work.

The people, who are converted into other religions, get new names. Their previous

religious symbols are replaced with the new ones. But still they are in the state of confusion unable to adopt the new beliefs as well as unable to forget their old habits. These people have switched over to other religions only for the fulfilment of their petty desires and comforts of this mundane life, but in the end there are only disappointments, pains, discomforts, confusion, chaos, unrest and violence.

The religious people loudly proclaim that love is the basic principle of their religions, but they do not hesitate to fight, hurt, and kill their opponents to establish their religions! It seems the basic principles of the religions have no effect on their followers in the daily life.

The new worshipping places nowadays have become noisy religious market places. The religious people propagate their beliefs from these worshipping places. Confusing rituals and false promises are dominant in these worshipping places. The devotional songs, amusing rituals, loud prayers and propagation lectures are drummed into the human ears from these worshipping places. The quietness of the

inner and outer of human beings is polluted with these loud prayers, rituals and lectures.

The worshipping places came into existence on the surface of Earth in the recent past of the human history that is only around 2000 years ago. They were mainly built upon the graves of wise people by their disciples. Those worshipping places were far away from the human habitation because the wise people used to live in the remote places with a few sincere and serious seekers.

Actually, those structures were built in the remembrance of wise people. Those monuments radiated peace, love and harmony of wise people. The disciples of wise people built those small monuments with at most care in remembrance of their beloved Masters. They lived there to cherish the memory of their Masters. They worshipped their Masters there. They remembered their Masters' life and teachings. They shared their experiences and associations with their Masters among themselves. They sat silently there and tried to erase their 'self' and merge themselves with the Divine Wholeness of their Masters.

Gradually more devotees resolved to live there to attain the Divine Wholeness. So, the rich people of those places or sometimes the Kings of those countries, who had also become the devotees of those Masters, expressed their desires to build huge and beautiful structures around the monuments in the remembrance of wise people as well to accommodate the new devotees.

On the acceptance of the disciples, they built beautiful structures upon or around the monuments. The Kings and other rich people of those places provided the basic needs for the serious seekers and devotees, who had been living there permanently. They considered providing the basic needs for the seekers and protecting the latter were the noble, divine duty of every individual.

In due course still more people wished to live their rest of the life in the vicinity of those worshipping places. Those devotees built their residential homes around the worshipping places. They lived there and visited the shrines daily. They believed that they would attain God

or heaven by the grace of wise people by praying to the latter at the worshipping places.

Lot of settlements grew around the worshipping places. The peace and solitude of the worshipping places have gone now and there are townships around all the ancient worshipping places with lot of noise and human activities.

The ancient structures of worshipping places are engineering marvels in some parts of the world. The structures in some places are so huge that one generation of people could not have completed the construction work. On those days there were no transportation facilities and no construction machineries. The people, who had the extraordinary wisdom in constructing the huge structures, designed and perfectly executed every stage of the construction with the help of the dedicated devotees and workers. Those great divine architects' names were not mentioned or remembered in the ancient worshipping places. It seems, those great dedicated people wanted to remain incognito.

The construction works of the ancient worshipping places had to be done manually. Lot of skilled as well as unskilled labourers worked hard for long time. In most of the cases better salary were paid to the workers. Somewhere slaves were used to build the worshipping places. Trained elephants, horses, oxen and donkeys were of great use in the construction works, carrying the building materials from far off places.

Several generations of people worked hard with the same enthusiasm for considerably long time to complete those structures. On seeing the massive, grand structures, one could understand the dedication and devotion of those people who had constructed them.

The kings and other common people had donated substantial money and properties to maintain those huge structures and feed the devotees who lived there. Most of the properties were taken for lease by the common devoted people. They paid the lease amount regularly in the form of money, grains, fruits and flowers, which were useful to

feed the devotees as well as to maintain the huge structures of the worshipping places.

It is really amazing to see the zealous and faith of those people, who built such massive worshipping places. The scientific, superb architectural plans of the ancient worshipping places surprise the present-day architects.

Those places were meant for the devotees who sought God. The devotees sat there in silence, remember wise people and meditate on their teachings, which would enable them to attain their ultimate goal, God. The divine songs and discourses on the teachings of wise people helped the new seekers to have the taste of real peace and joy. Those places turned out to be the homes for seekers and seers. In due course human settlements came into existence around such places.

Some wise people of later times had encouraged their devotees to build structures, where the devotees could assemble and remember God. Those places were filled with aura of wise people even after their demise. Those places became the

learning centres. They radiated peace and joy among the people. They alleviated the sufferings of people by showering clarity and wisdom of life and God.

After the wise people breathed their last, the devotees buried their physical remains inside those structures. In some cases, the upper caste people among the devotees of wise people, out of their ignorance, slowly dominated, possessed and converted the whole structures into religious worshipping places according to their fanciful whims. They commenced religious rituals forgetting the very purpose of those places. They made their settlements around those worshipping places. Anyhow these holy places continue to stand majestically in spite of the corrupted people's occupation and their mismanagement.

Initially, most of the disciples and devotees of the Masters had lived in those holy places. They sat before the graves of their beloved Masters and meditated upon the latter's teachings with ever growing devotion. They passionately tried to

realize their oneness with their Masters in their lifetime.

In due course, after the occupation of the corrupted religious people in those holy shrines, the sincere devotees had to flee from there. The disciples and devotees who wanted to meditate upon their Masters and their teachings faced severe hardships in their own Masters' places. They felt that they could not live anymore there among the different power centres. They did not want either to compete with those people, who craved for name, fame, power and authority. So, they left the place silently. They learned to live alone, either in their own places or in some other secluded places. There they meditated and tried to realize their oneness with their Masters. Some had succeeded in their venture and some other died during the process of attaining the oneness with their Masters.

The religious oriented people, who had occupied the shrines, engaged some people of their own beliefs to maintain the monuments. Those people were normally from upper castes. They were accommodated in the quarters situated within

the complex of the worshipping places. They performed the works like cleaning the graves of the Masters and decorating them with garlands consisting of beautiful fragrant flowers. They lighted huge lamps that shed light on the graves. They sang songs glorifying God and Masters. Those songs were composed and tuned earlier by the disciples and devotees of wise people. They also started doing strange rituals to worship God. The rituals attracted the common masses.

The rituals vary from place to place and religion to religion. They were done regularly, at specific times, but devoid of love, faith and spirit. The ritualistic routines were conducted mechanically, but professionally. The rituals attracted more people. People from different walks of life came there to attend the rituals. In due course people believed that organizing the performance of rituals at the monuments would bring them good fortunes. They offered money to conduct the rituals. Later conducting the rituals became the livelihood for the upper caste people.

The occupants of those shrines organized to conduct more rituals regularly. The common

people, who were enchanted on seeing the glittering rituals, offered substantial money as their contribution. The people, who ran those shrines, were encouraged by the generous offerings. They tried to attract more crowds by adding still more glittering rituals.

The upper caste occupants and their assistants became the priests. Their successors later claimed the ownership of those monuments. They spent most of the offerings to the growth and popularity of the worshipping places. They beautified the monuments and built many more structures around the monument with architectural beauty. They installed statues or symbols of their religious beliefs, either made in stone or in metal. The statues and the symbols became the centre point of attraction and were considered the holiest part of the monument. The religious rituals were conducted regularly on those statues and symbols. Such, the monuments of wise people had been converted into religious worshipping places. The upper caste people didn't allow the other castes people to enter into the so called sanctum sanctorum, where the statues and symbols were erected. The songs that

were connected with wise people and their teachings were conveniently replaced with the religious hymns in unknown languages.

The dominant religious people, who administered those worshipping places, decorated the statues and symbols with precious jewellery, which had been donated by the rich devotees. The utensils that were used for conducting rituals were either made in Gold or in silver. Such glittering and expensive way of performing the rituals was possible only due to the generous offerings of devotees.

The priests propagated false notions that conducting certain rituals at the worshipping places focusing on the statues and symbols would bring great fortunes and drive away the evils, pains, and problems of life.

The religious priests in some part of the world had explained to the masses that all the events in one's life were controlled by the planets. The innocent suffering people were misled by such priests, who influenced them to conduct some specific rituals at the shrines to appease the

planets. The cunning priests declared that it was the only way to escape from the wrath of planets. The people believed those preaching and arranged to conduct the rituals out of fear and greed. They spent lot of money on rituals to get out of the turmoil they faced in their lives.

Though the people performed all such rituals their problems persisted in one way or other. They were not able to come out of their pains and problems permanently even after they had wholeheartedly conducted the religious rituals at the shrines.

There are nature's laws that govern the whole world. Every action results in equal opposite reaction. The happenings in one's life are dictated by one's previous or present actions. That is the prime message of wise people. They preached that remembering God alone would bring permanent solace, peace and wisdom to the aching minds.

The wisdom that is attained by remembering God would energize one to understand the reality of actions. The wisdom would also enlighten people

the futility of shouldering the 'self' and helps people to drop the 'self'. The 'self' is the feeler of the pains and pleasures and so when there is no 'self' there is no pain and no pleasures too. This wisdom alone would wipe away all the problems of life.

The people would then understand and see that everything happens, happens by the glorious power of God and nothing could be altered. Nothing could be imperfect too as everything is done by God. One should understand that the apparent imperfection is the subtle form of the perfection. This realization would lead people to surrender and submit everything to God. They would become totally free from the mundane life, its desires, pleasures and the consequent pains and problems. They shed off their 'self' and merge with God. Such great souls are the real wise people. Any religious beliefs and rituals cannot bring this transformation from human to divine. One should transcend religions, beliefs and 'self' to become one with God.

The religious people created and conducted still more colourful rituals and festivals in the

worshipping places to attract more crowds. In due course the rituals and festivals became the limelight of the worshipping places and the same had slowly erased the significance of the wise people in those worshipping people. The ancient huge and holy worshipping places are supposed to be the learning centres of wise people's teachings, but, the propagation of the religious beliefs and domination of the religious rituals shatter the very purpose of these holy places. It happens everywhere around the world on the graves of wise people. It is painful for the true sensible seekers.

The people who administered the worshipping places, named the deities and symbols. The names became popular and gradually the worshipping places were addressed by those names. Lot of people came from far off places to those worshipping places to worship and demand remedy for their pains and problems. If a person got what he demanded, he would imagine that he got it from the Gods of those worshipping places. He would go on narrating his so-called divine experiences to everyone he met. It would influence other people to follow suit and in due

course lot of people would start visiting those worshipping places.

These days demanding something from God and offering something to God at the religious worshipping places have become the mode of devotion to God. People believe that if their life is enriched with something it is due to their devotion to Gods in these worshipping places. If they fail to get something and if they lose something or somebody, they would philosophize that it's due to their fate, bad time and wrong position of the planets.

This awkward philosophy is spreading among the people right from the places of wise people. It is totally contradictory to the basic thoughts of wise people. The people who propagate such false philosophies among the masses never know the seriousness of the consequential spiritual disaster that would befall on the whole humanity. That's what is happening in the present-day life around the world.

Ignorance alone prevails and wisdom is ignored. The truth of action, reaction and inaction, which

have been discovered and preached by wise people remain mere theory and they are not applied by the people in their daily life. Again some wise people should come periodically to erase the false notions of religious people, by imparting the wisdom of life and God.

The wise people have asked mankind to work hard for the needs of life. There should be absolute honesty and sincerity. Whatever people get from their hard works, they should accept them with satisfaction and joy. They should not evaluate the results of their hard works. This is one of the perfect ways that show the mankind the path and destination of life.

The destination is the awareness and realization of God's presence and becoming one with God. The wise people have emphasized that the paths to the destination are more important than the destination itself, because, in fact the path itself is the destination.

The wise people have told that it is foolishness to get disappointed by the failures in pursuing the destination. They assure that every failure brings

wisdom in one's life. The wise people have pointed out to the mankind that whatever one sow, that alone would sprout. So they teach people to think and do good things to reap positive results. They have preached that living in content with whatever has been provided by The Great Providence, loving and serving the fellow beings are the great good deeds of life. Not hurting others either physically or psychologically is also one of the great noble acts.

They have also preached people that remembering God is the real life and forgetting God is equal to painful death. While people remember God, they spontaneously love all, do virtuous things and live in joy. While they forget God, they tempt to do evil and subsequently they suffer and perish. The worshipping places could be utilized to remember God, but should not be considered as magic houses that would provide everything one demand.

One should realize that there is no need to demand anything from God and this undemanding state makes one deserve to receive the abundances of God's Grace. God's grace

shouldn't be translated into the accumulation of power, pleasures and wealth. God's grace is all meant about love, peace, clarity, renunciation and wisdom. God's grace would naturally prompt one to renounce everything one has.

If God's grace is not received properly, there would be disorder, pain, and problems in the daily life. That's why the wise people have instructed mankind to focus mental energy on the contemplation of God, without demanding anything from God. The people could remember and worship God either in the worshipping places or in any other clean, hygienic and natural atmosphere in total solitude.

If one can contemplate God, one does not need to worry about his or her basic needs of life. Such devotees shall be looked after by God. If somebody wants to have extraordinary wealth and power then he should work for it, but at the same time he should prepare himself to face the consequences of surplus and authority.

Greed always breeds anxiety, fear, anger, and pain. Most of the people always demand

something from God without working for it honestly. They always compare their positions with others. The comparison breeds envy. The envy causes anger that results in violence. A violent heart can never communicate with God even in the great, popular worshipping places.

Generally the people demand God to fulfil their desires even though the wise people have drummed the fact that God is not a servant to anybody. Passionately remembering God without any demand is the real devotion and this devotion alone would take one to the abode of God.

Normally it is very difficult to remember God without an image or form. So the wise people preached to the masses to see all the fellow beings as God's manifestations. Of course one needs extraordinary energy and courage to see God in everything and love everyone. So, the wise people created Names of Gods and invested all their spiritual energy in those Divine Names. They initiated the seekers into the remembrance of God's Names.

Remembering God's Names with unshakable faith kindles the wisdom and love within. The faithful seekers, who remember God's Names constantly, see the wise people as the divine forms. By remembering God's Names and Forms of wise people, one could transcend the mortal names and forms of the mundane life and live the life with love and joy. All their attachments would disappear and there comes the glimpse of the Immortal Immensity. It gives ecstasy, but doesn't last long. The mind starts contemplating the source of the vision. The contemplation kindles one's intelligence that enquires the vision of the Immortal Immensity. The mind is unable to find it out. One's intellect and knowledge is inadequate to find out the truth. The more the mind tries, deeper the mystery goes.

The serious seeker begins to see and observe everything around him and within him. The appearance and happenings, both within and outside his being, help him to see the transient nature of everything. Finally he discovers that everything is mortal in this world. The mind which realizes the mortality of the world sees that it itself is mortal. It understands that death is

imminent for everything. As soon as this basic wisdom dawns on human mind, there appears the totality of Immortal Beauty, which the mind has never seen earlier. The divine beauty, which is omniscient, omnipresent, and omnipotent, absorbs the whole mind and body consciousness of the seekers.

The mind with its thought process is gone, withered. They see God, God alone. They realize that God alone is the doer of everything. Finally the seekers become one with God. These holy people are called “Wise People”. They see their mission clearly now. They start working on people. Everything is perfect for these great wise people, because everything is done by God. They could not be perturbed. The real love and wisdom flow from them.

One should remember such wise people and it is the way to remember God. The wise people and God are one and the same. The real meditation is remembering these great wise people. That is the real devotion. This devotion makes one transcend the desires. The heart that has

transcended the desires becomes fearless. This fearless state leads one to the abode of God.

The fearless devotee never demands or desires anything. The people, who demand and desire for silly and mundane things, are cowards and they cannot be in joy and helpful to the society. The wise people continuously work to mould the human beings and make them fearless and selfless. This is the prime work of all wise people of different times around the world.

Nowadays most of the popular religious worshipping places have become the places of superstitions. The purpose of them has been badly mixed up with the fantasy of false beliefs and superstitions.

Nowadays they attract multiple crowds. The popularity of these worshipping places reaches far off places. The people, who find it difficult to get time to visit these far off original shrines, would build small replicas that are similar to the original worshipping places nearby their dwelling areas by collecting money from the public. In due course it becomes the livelihood

for them. It also becomes a place of social gathering.

These worshipping places that are not connected with the wise people will decay and disappear in mysterious ways. Sometimes the structures of such religious worshipping places have been destroyed by the rival religionists. On the contrary the monuments or the worshipping places that have been built on the grave of wise people stand majestically and eternally radiating the divine energy. They enlighten the real seekers, who focus their attention on the teachings of wise people.

There are several such huge as well as simple and beautiful engineering marvels of architecture in the form of worshipping places in some part of the world. They have obviously religious labels. Still, if one happens to visit any one of them and understands the value of the teachings of wise man on whose grave the whole structure has been built, he would get the transformation. Even though a lot of noisy rituals and religious propagation are ceaselessly continuing in these worshipping places, the real seekers can derive



the divine wisdom of wise people radiating in deep silence from such holy places.

Off late a lot of worshipping places are constructed by the religionists according to their fanatic whim in competition with the other religions. These worshipping places, instead of cultivating love and devotion, help to develop communal disharmony and disorder in the society. The creation of such worshipping places of different religions attracts the hatred of their opponents. These structures have become the centre of violence and they are damaged, destroyed and somewhere burnt into ashes, occasionally along with human beings too. It is evident that the real worshipping places cannot be possible without the direct presence of wise people. The worshipping places that are radiating peace and bliss are due to the presence of wise people and not due to the religious fervours or beliefs of any nature.

## **7. God, The Truth**

God is not a subject to study, discuss and debate. God is neither an object to analyse and evaluate. God is not a concept as well. God has neither form nor is formless. God does not belong to any gender even. One of the wise men has said, “God is neither He nor She but remains a Mystery.”

Humans since from the dawn of intelligence has tried to find out “What is God? Who is God?” This question lingers on some of the serious human minds. Very few of them have ventured into the wilderness of the world in search of God.

The normal believers have no problem to answer this question. They would conveniently quote the past and present scholars’ theories and thesis and try to exhibit their knowledge on God’s existence. However they are not able to conclusively establish God’s presence with concrete proofs. So, they either try to evade from this uneasy question or would conclude with the simple answer that God is a matter of faith, belief. The religious heads also have taught people that

probing and questioning about God's existence is anti-God, blasphemy. Non-believing is a sin. That's the concept of the believers.

The believers of God are mostly religionists. The non-believers have their own cult, which too contains superstitions and imaginations. One cannot see much difference between them. Both are adamant in their concepts, but they would never venture into the understanding of truth behind God.

The believers do not know what they believe, and the non-believers do not wish to know what God is. Both the believers and non-believers do not have the energy, efficiency, intelligence and seriousness to probe into God. They fear to probe and meditate. They are afraid because, they imagine that in the process of searching God, they would lose their 'self' and life.

So, they are always evasive saying that they do not have the time to probe or meditate. They have the time to imagine, desire, believe and argue some concepts, but they cannot spare time to contemplate God sincerely! It is the general

attitude of both the believers and non-believers. They feel safe in their religions and concepts.

The believers say that their ancestors, elders and all the past and present great wise people of the world have believed in God and so they also have the belief in God. It is convenient and safe for them to follow somebody or something. They naturally have the attitude to follow someone, because, following is easier than probing and following doesn't have the risks of losing their possession.

The followers are called devotees, believers. These ardent (?) devotees perform religious rituals and believe that their performance of rituals would bring them peace and bliss in their life. The peace and bliss of these believers are sheer imagination rather hallucination. If suppose they face one small challenge in their life, their apparent peace and bliss would disappear from them and they would become dangerously unpredictable. They may even go to the extent of damaging themselves as well as their surroundings too.

The atheists are passionate to exhibit their intellectual capability of arguing about God and religious beliefs. These people also do not have the seriousness. They do not have the courage, intelligence and energy to find out the truth of God. God is just a play thing for them to while away the time, but, when serious problems or pains occur in their personal life, their principles, concepts and attitudes towards God will vanish. They do not have the fortitude to withstand the challenges of life. They would seriously and sincerely search for the ways to escape from their pains and problems.

If the pains and problems are still more severe and serious, they do not mind consulting the best astrologers or popular God Men of any religion. They would even perform odd rituals that have been suggested by the astrologers or God Men of different religions. All they want is relief from the pains and problems. It's all so childish. And these absurd, weak, and cowardly creatures are commenting on God and arguing about God!

The people who believe God without direct perception as well as the people who disbelieve

God without attempting to probe God, both are equally idiotic according to wise people.

The believers frequently quote wise people's words, "God is everywhere. God is omnipotent and omniscient! God is Love personification. God is full of compassion. God creates, God protects, and God destroys."

The religious oriented people repeat these words quite often to exhibit their belief, devotion, and knowledge about God. These egoistic pious people conclude their knowledge of God with specific theories of popular wise people and feel proud of them. Their solid proud ego gets shattered when life challenges them personally. A mild disorder of the physical system or loss of something or somebody shall shatter their beings.

If the loss and pain happen to others, they do not mind preaching the sufferers about God and His way of action according to their beliefs. But, when the same loss and pain occurs to them, they would run away from their beliefs and concepts. They are shocked and bewildered. Such people

do not mind switching over to other beliefs or religions and in some cases, they would even become atheists.

Only a few among the sufferers start contemplating seriously the secrets of life and God. In due course they would understand the importance of wise people. They realize that the wise people alone can initiate them into the understanding of Life and God. After this realization they start searching for wise people to get rid of their doubts and pains.

Generally, during the tough times, both the believers and non-believers have more trust and belief on astrologers, religious bigheads, and rituals at various worshipping places irrespective of their religious orientation. The question of God or no-God thesis does not arise at all during their crisis times. Sometimes these people do not hesitate to demolish or modify their own living houses if some learned bigheads blame the erratic constructions of their houses that have brought them the bad luck. Poor bricks of the houses bear the brunt of ignorance.

Some people would change their names according to numerology. Some others would be advised to use particular colour dresses and wear rings with the prescribed precious stones to escape from the bad luck. Such, both the believers and non-believers try in childish ways to get relief from the sorrows and problems.

Very few of the sufferers opt for wise people during their horrible times. The wise people in turn impart the wisdom of life into their aching hearts. Very soon the affected people come out of their sufferings by the grace and guidance of wise people. But once they are relieved from the sufferings, most of them continue their old conventional way of life, forgetting the teachings of wise people. Only a few continue to have the faith in wise people and their teachings. They remember wise people and their teachings constantly and in due course they achieve the proximity of wise people.

Slowly they would see the purpose of human life. This 'seeing' happens only due to their association with the wise people. They realize that erasing the 'self' and merging with God is the

purpose of life. One or two among them successfully attain God by the grace of wise people and the rest struggles throughout their life.

Most of the human beings are so weak, cheap and silly that none is ready to face the problems and sorrows of life, understand them and try to get rid of them by their own efforts without blaming others or God. They are crazy. The sufferers crave to escape from their problems, which are mostly caused by their own misdeeds.

In that situation they do not mind running behind anyone. They search for the best astrologers and popular religious God Men. They pour out their pains and problems to the latter. They are baffled if their pains and problems continue to haunt them even after the fulfilment of the astrologers' and religious bigheads' suggestions and directions. They do not know what to do further.

Most of them turn violent and harm their immediate surroundings. The cowards among the sufferers take refuge in alcohol or drugs. A few among them even commit suicide. Some

other would run away from their places and wander to escape from their problems. These are the attitudes of both believers and non-believers during the time of crisis. Such people desire to have only comforts, pleasures, fame, name, power and trouble-free life. They do not have the aptitude for the understanding of Truth of Life or Truth of God.

There are Nature's Laws. They are irrevocable. In fact these laws are governing the whole cosmos. We are not aware of it, but still it is the obvious truth. When one seeks pleasure and works for it sincerely, one can get it. One of the greatest wise men has said, "Man is the Master of his own destiny." The desires and actions of the mankind dictate the consequential events in human life.

Another famous saying of a wise man is, "Desires are the root cause for all evils". Everyone desires to enjoy the life, but most of the time it ends in pain. The pleasures and pains are time-bound. The pleasures one enjoy now might turn painful at some other time and the pains would initiate one into the path of joy and peace at different

time. The pains and pleasures occur in everybody's life due to the desires.

That's why another wise man has declared, "Deserve first, you need not desire". But, if one desires without deserving, there shall be certainly pain and disappointments. In the process of fulfilling the undeserved desires, mistrust, doubts and fear would arise in one's heart and confuse them. This confusion would prevent them from accepting the outcome of their desires. They doubt everything. Their confidence and conviction are gone. They become depressed and dejected. They feel guilty and are shattered. In this way the whole mankind suffers and nowadays it has become the way of normal human life all over the world.

Both the believers and non-believers suffer due to the numerous pains and problems in their life despite their beliefs and concepts. When a person focuses all his or her attention on a particular problem, perceives its root cause and then acts on them, the problem could be solved.

The people normally believe this as God's Grace. Again if some other new problems arise in their life, they might not have the same energy to focus and act on the problems. They seek relief from God in different worshipping places and saintly persons. Once their problems are solved, they would again return to their conventional routine life. It is a continuous process that has no end. They call this repetition 'life'.

The different emotions, demands and desires drag human in all directions and make them suffering and struggling. The people fail to understand that life that has pleasures, pains, problems and remedies is only transient, just like the passing clouds. Nothing is permanent, everlasting. Everything that is visible and observable is mortal. The subtle feelings and thoughts of all living beings are also momentary. They are all bound to change.

The human demands and desires shift from one to another frequently and confuse people. In the end there is death waiting around the corner for everybody and everything. Confused and

frightened of death, the human minds entangle in the vast web of superstitions.

Some of the religious people imagine that they would remain immortal, and some other vexed souls believe that death is the greatest boon for them as it seems to give permanent break from the complicated and messy problems of life. Very few alone know that death is only a pause and there is a continuity waiting. The cycle of life continues, till the 'self' and its content, desires, wither away. Getting released from this continuity is the goal of life, the wise people say.

Generally God's grace is being measured with good and bad events of life. But the truth is, the so called good and bad events are not the appropriate indicator to prove God's existence or God's grace. The good and bad are like the two sides of a single coin. When the good exists, the bad too exists. They are the results of the actions and reactions.

If one does good things in his life, he will be rewarded with beneficial things in life. If the same person does bad things, he is bound to get

the consequent bad results. A normal human life consists of both good and bad deeds. However the good and bad are not definable by the normal human beings. The good and bad are time-bound and are mostly beyond the comprehension of human intellect.

The ignorance of good and bad causes pain. There is pain in everybody's life. Thus the whole mankind suffers and finally everyone dies at the appropriate time. Death is unavoidable and irrevocable. It is always there around the corner waiting for us. That's the nature's law. Whether it is good or bad, death occurs to everyone.

If one wants to lead a peaceful and happy life, one should adhere to the basic virtues of human life prescribed by wise people. Of course, this might not offer the wholeness of bliss and Realization of God.

A subtle unknown sorrow and a deep longing for some unknown mysterious thing would always haunt the human beings. A normal intelligence cannot sensibly identify the thing that has been longed. No worldly affair could quench this

longing. The perceptive, sensible people, who are aware of this fact, passionately venture into the wilderness of world in search of this unknown. They struggle and suffer for long time in search of this mysterious thing. Finally, they find out that they long for the Immortality, God.

Once they know that they are searching for God, it would become easy for them to see the obstacle that prevents them attaining God. They could see that only their 'self' blocks them from perceiving God. As long as one retains one's 'self' and wishes its welfare, one has to go through the pleasures and pains of life. The 'self' is nothing but a bundle of desires and the desires are the root cause for every disorder in the world. They also discover that the 'self' divides and the absence of 'self' unites everything in the Universe.

Even then they struggle to find out the Immortality, God, because they use their 'self' to attain the ultimate Wholeness. Finally, a few of them realize that they cannot attain and see God through the 'self'. These people shall be directed to the Holy Feet of wise people by the Divine Providence. The association with wise people

shall energize them to transcend all the beliefs and finally the wise people help them to let go the 'self'.

Thus, their search for the unknown God successfully ends and they become totally one with the wise people. Merging with wise people and merging with God, both are one and the same. The wise people are the embodiments of God. These privileged people, who have dissolved their being in wise people, are released from their body conscious, the 'self'. They become free from all mundane pleasures, pains and unknown sorrows. They are fearless because they have no 'self' to fear and desire. Such blessed people see God in everything. They perceive God alone, which is full of Energy. They realize, God is the cause for all existence.

God manifests in everything. It never comes and goes. It is visible as well as invisible. It alone exists everywhere. It is both static and dynamic at the same time. Having been static and dynamic at the same time, God is beyond the comprehension of human intellect and mind.

Everyone wants to see God, talk to God, and demand something from God through the 'self', whereas seeing and communicating with God is impossible through the heavily loaded 'self'. But it is possible to become one with God by shedding off the 'self'. Absence of the 'self' is a must to see God. Even though the 'self' too is the product of God, the 'self' should dissolve in the Divine, in the Infinite Vastness of God. That's the beauty of this game, Life. The 'self' should cease to exist while one is alive. The blessed people understand this divine truth by the grace of wise people.

The concrete evidence for God's existence is the great wise people of this world of all times. This statement is not an imaginary fiction. It is not either based upon any religious concepts. If we are able to be one with the wise people and their works, we could see them that they are none other than God. Their prime work is to elevate the eligible devoted souls and merge them with God.

After merging with God, we shall proclaim silently "God alone exists, nobody else, nothing

else". This declaration would sound loudly through our deeds of life but in utter silence physically. There is no differentiation, no division, no religion, no rituals, no conflict, no violence, no limitation, no border, no war, no I and no you. There is one, one alone. There is bliss and absolute peace. All the dualities disappear. There remains only God. No sins, no virtues, no good and no bad, but God alone is everywhere, beyond time, beyond thoughts, beyond mind and beyond intelligence.

These are not mere concepts. If one wants to check the veracity of this statement, let him go to a real wise man. Let him surrender to the holy feet of wise man with all the passion to know the truth of God. He will not find it that easy to become one with the wise man. It shall take long time, even some decades, like a seed sprouts into a plant, further grows into a tree, flowers and then yields fruits.

If the seeking is real, one day he or she shall lose his or her 'self' and merge into the totality of God. He or she shall be totally transformed and become the forms of God. They will become great

inspiration for the common people. This long process needs lot of energy and courage. Is there any real hero, who wants to become one with God? The wise people of the whole world are waiting for such heroes patiently to make the latter Immortals.

Death occurs only to the mortals. The Immortals are those who live in God, live for God and live as God. The immortals, the wise people, are called by different names. Mostly they live in solitude. They seem to be living and dying like any other normal human beings, but they remain in deathless state even after their death. They are omnipresent, omniscient and omnipotent. They are the real Immortals.

The tradition of such great wise people has started from the time of human existence, and it shall continue till the time every human gets absolute evolution by merging with the ultimate goal, God. These are not mere concepts of any religious back up. It is absolute truth. If one wants to check up the truth of this statement, they must be serious. They must seek wise people with passion. In due course the wise

people shall reveal their reality. After perceiving the truth, one shall not remain the same. One's whole being get transformation and his old way of life would wither away.

The fear of this transformation prevents most of the mankind to approach wise people. They are afraid of losing themselves, their identity. This fear psychosis terrifies mankind and makes them run away from the wise people. That's why the wise people have declared that God is meant for heroes and not for cowards.

Once the seekers taste the bliss of wise people they shall reach the destination without much pain and trouble. It happens to the heroes due to the grace of wise people. The wise people easily identify the real hero and the coward. They know who is eligible and who is not. They create various situations in the lives of seekers that shall provoke the latter to seek God. It is all mysterious, but it's true. The common people would also get the benefit of wise people's teachings. They gradually understand the virtues of life. They would try to love and serve at least

their own dear and near and in due course they would come across the divinity.

It is not that easy to locate wise people. They may be in disguise of beggars or rich, clean shaven or with uncombed hair and beard. They may be highly educated or school dropouts, in modern dress or in rags. They may be naked or in religious robs. They may live in total solitude or they may be in the religious places or in the midst of crowded public places. They may be in the form of a responsible family man or woman or a lazy vagabond. They may belong to any continent.

Despite their various appearances, the Purity, Divinity, Joy, Wisdom, and the Absolute Peace are always radiating from their beings. It is a great privilege to see such a wise man in one's life time.
